Plant the future: KPMG plants 4000 trees with BOS+ for a greener planet

The KPMG Forest is an investment in the future of our planet and a greener environment to enjoy for generations to come.

- KPMG in Belgium's people and their families plant 4000 native trees
- The KPMG Forest spans 1,6 hectares, equivalent to three soccer fields
- KPMG in Belgium partnered with BOS+ for this long-term reforestation project

Holsbeek, Belgium, 20 and 21 January 2024 – The KPMG community comes together to plant the KPMG Forest, giving 4000 trees a new home in Holsbeek.

Giving back to nature and our communities is an essential aspect of life at KPMG and integral to our values and culture. The forest serves as a strong symbol and demonstration of our commitment to sustainability and investments in projects that align with Our Impact Plan. That's why the planting weekend is more than just a one-off planting ceremony: it was important to us to acquire the domain and partner up with BOS+ for a long-term collaboration.

Over 400 KPMG people and family come together during the planting days to give 4000 saplings a new home in Holsbeek. The site spans 1,6 hectares, equivalent to the size of three soccer fields, and was meticulously chosen for its central location and accessibility. BOS+ carefully selected a perfect mix of local tree species to reforest the plot. In the future, the KPMG Forest will be an oasis for forest bathing, a dedicated place for everyone to enjoy the benefits of being in nature.

Bert Somviele, Director of BOS+: "To be able to create new forests in a region with so few trees and nature, is a very rewarding and worthwhile endeavor. For BOS+, this has been a strategic goal for many years, but the fact that more and more companies such as KPMG are actively supporting us in doing this and that we can plant the trees together with the people of KPMG, gives us a lot of extra energy to fulfill this ambition."
