Bahrain

National Bureau for Revenue (NBR) updates Domestic Minimum Top-Up Tax (DMTT) guides

Treaty update

On 18 June 2025, the 'Bahrain - Russia Mutual Assistance Agreement' (2025) was signed in Saint Petersburg.

First DMTT advance payment due by 31 August 2025

For in-scope Multinational Enterprise (MNE) groups with a 31 December year end, the deadline for the first advance payment to be made by the filing Constituent Entity (CE) is 31 August 2025.

In the latest <u>Tax Alert</u> prepared by the KPMG Bahrain tax team, we have discussed various key aspects from the recent NBR guidance on DMTT advance payment procedure.

With less than 14 days until the deadline for the first DMTT advance payment, MNE groups with 31 December year end should finalize their advance payment computation with supporting documentation to ensure compliance.

Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA)

Zakat, Tax and Customs Authority (ZATCA) to conduct tax and zakat workshops

- On 18 August 2025, ZATCA will conduct virtual workshops on the Duty-Free markets, the integration phase of e-invoicing, and on the foreign companies' income tax and withholding tax obligations.
- On 19 August 2025, ZATCA will conduct virtual workshops on the "Cancellation of Fines and Exemption of Penalties" initiative, and on the integration phase of e-invoicing.
- On 20 August 2025, ZATCA will conduct virtual workshops on the VAT refund procedure for eligible persons, the VAT registration process, and on the zakat-payers' rights and obligations.

- On 7 August 2025, Russia and the UAE signed a trade agreement on services and investments, in Moscow.
- According to a recent press release, a fourth round of negotiations for a comprehensive economic partnership agreement between Japan and the UAE took place from 4 to 8 August 2025.
