

#### **Chilean Concession System**

The MOP, through the Office of Concessions (DGC), has the mission of promoting the Public-Private Partnership policy, which has significantly increased the state's assets by allowing private financing and management schemes to cover important gaps in public infrastructure, as well as increasing connectivity and the quality of life of the inhabitants of different areas of the country.

The main types of concession of the Chilean system are:

- Roads
- Hospitals
- Airports
- Dams
- Others


The main phases of the Chilean concession system are:

- Development: Evaluates the feasibility of projects
- Bidding: Prequalifies, receives bids and award
- · Construction: Controls quality and risk management
- Operation: Ensures the correct operation and maintenance of the works associated with the contract.

# Roads (1/10)

#### 2nd Road Concession Route 5 Santiago - Los Vilos



18.Jul.24 Bidding tender



USD 1,273 million



223 km

The project consists of the improvement of 218 km of the Route 5, in the section between the city of Santiago and the town of Los Vilos, through the roadway expansion that are under study. Four lanes are planned between Buenaventura and Lampa, and three lanes between Lampa and the Nogales-Puchuncaví junction (except for Cuesta Las Chilcas that is maintained in its current profile). In addition, the Concession includes the concession of the 5.2 km long El Melón Tunnel.

The project considers new junctions, crossings, the replacement of some bridges, route rectifications to leave a uniform speed of 120 km/hr and stretches of 100 km/hr, new sections of service roads, replacement and new pedestrian walkways, replacement of all retaining barriers, new service areas and improvement and expansion of existing ones, among others.

#### Road Concession Route Pie de Monte



9.Aug.24 Bidding tender



USD 416 million



20 km

The project corresponds to the development of an alternative road to the current Route 160, in the section between the communes of San Pedro de la Paz and Coronel, which has experienced great growth in recent years.

The project considers a route along the edge of the hills, to the east of Route 160, which will connect to the north with the Puente Industrial Road Concession, which is currently under construction, and to the south with the Route 160 Concession, Coronel - Tres Pinos section. Among the benefits of the initiative is the improvement of connectivity in the Bío Bío Region, thanks to the construction of a high standard route, with an electronic toll gantry system and an expected travel speed of 120 km/hour.





# **Roads** (2/10)

#### 2nd Road Concession Northern Access to Concepción



27.Aug.24 Bidding tender



USD 564 million



96 km

The project consists of a dual carriageway highway extending 75 km from km 413.2 of Route 5 South (approximately 11 km south of Chillán) to its junction with Route 150 CH, which connects Penco with Concepción, in the Bío Bío Region. In addition, 14 km of branch roads will be added.

The initiative includes widening the route to give uniformity to the segregated median profile with defenses, rehabilitating the existing roadways, rectifying layouts and enabling new bridges and sections of service roads.

It also contemplates a new connection between the Acceso Norte a Concepción highway and the Concepción Cabrero highway, in the vicinity of Concepción's urban center.

#### 2nd Road Concession Route 5 Temuco - Río Bueno

USD 878 million



182 km

The project corresponds to the improvement of 181.75 km of the current Route 5 in the section between Temuco and Río Bueno.

The project covers the Regions of La Araucanía and Los Ríos and considers the development of new bridges, footbridges, bus stops and new junctions, parking areas for dangerous loads and a bypass to the city of Los Lagos.

The project incorporates improvements to the existing signaling, incorporation of universal accessibility, and seismic upgrading of the structures.

Among the benefits of the project is that it will improve connectivity in the south of the country and favor commercial, tourism and agro-industrial exchange in the region.



# **Roads** (3/10)

#### 2nd Road Concession Route 68, Santiago - Valparaíso - Viña del Mar



15.Oct.24 Bidding tender



USD 1,222 million



141 km

The project corresponds to the improvement and capacity expansion of the current Route 68 and its branches, with a total length of 140.7 km.

It includes the widening to third lanes up to the Costanera junction and then to fourth lanes up to the Lo Prado toll booth (approximately km 17) and the necessary improvements to make the roadway layout consistent with the speed of traffic. From km 17 to km 99.80, a new roadway with two lanes will be planned parallel to and adjacent to the current route.

It also contemplates the development of two new tunnels at Lo Prado and Zapata and the replacement of the bridges over the Mapocho River and the Pudahuel estuary.

#### Road Concession Route 5 Chacao - Chonchi

USD 665



126 km

The project consists in improving the Route 5 in Chiloé, between the southern access of the new bridge over the Chacao Channel and the northern junction to Chonchi, with an approximate length of 126 km.

It includes the construction of a second bridge over the Pudeto River and a short 1 km bypass in the city of Ancud. In addition, maintenance and operation of the bypass in the city of Castro (16 km) built by the MOP is also considered.

Among the benefits of the work is to reduce travel times and increase safety along the route, which is expected to favor commercial, productive and service interchange in the area.





# Roads (4/10)

#### Road Concession Route 5 Caldera - Antofagasta



2024 Bidding call



USD 931 million



466 km

The project corresponds to the expansion, improvement, conservation and operation of Route 5 in the section between the end of the concession Route 5 Vallenar-Caldera section, up to the current concession Highways of the Antofagasta Region, with an extension of approximately 466.2 km.

This highway's preliminary design considers the development of a dual carriageway with two lanes in each direction and a service speed of 120 km/hr, with the standard used in all the country's concessioned highways.

#### Road Concession Route 5 Antofagasta - Iquique

USD 720 million



353 km

The project corresponds to the widening to dual carriageway of Route 5 in the section between the cities of Antofagasta and Iquique, from the Carmen Alto sector until the access to Iquique on Route 16 in the Humberstone sector.

The work considers the development of new returns and junctions and unleveled railroad crossings, general services and emergency service areas, pedestrian walkways and SOS posts).

The benefits of this initiative include improved safety standards, resistance to seismic movements and other natural hazards, and a design speed of 120 km/hr.





# **Roads** (5/10)

#### Connections to Valdivia



2024 Bidding call



USD 675 million



87 km

The project corresponds to the widening, improvement, maintenance and operation of Route 202 and Route 206 in the Los Ríos Region, with an extension of 44.3 km and 43.1 km, respectively. Both roads are planned as dual carriageways with two lanes in each direction. The project includes the replacement of existing bridges, construction of new bridges, pedestrian walkways, bus stops and interchanges.

It is designed with high road safety standards, infrastructure with universal accessibility, service and rest areas, tourist areas with viewpoints and a memorial.

This work will improve connectivity with the city of Valdivia, while favoring commercial, tourism and agro-industrial exchange in the region.

#### Road Concession for Electric Vehicles in Concepción Route 150



2024 Bidding call



USD 180 million



12 km

The project considers the construction and maintenance of two public transportation corridors located in the center of the axis of the Concepción Talcahuano Highway Section II and Route 150.

In addition, the project will provide stopping platforms in the medians that separate the corridor from the external roads for private vehicles. A bi-directional bicycle lane is also considered in both corridors.





# Roads (6/10)

#### 2nd Road Concession Route 57 Santiago - Colina - Los Andes



2024 Bidding call



**USD 900** million



109 km

The project consists of the expansion and improvement of Route 57 CH, which connects Santiago, in the Metropolitan Region, and Route 60 to the east of the city of Los Andes, in the Valparaíso Region.

The route is 108.7 km long and includes branches to Auco-San Felipe (Route E-89 9), Chacabuco-Polpaico (Route G 71) and San José-Lo Pinto (Route G 73).

The initiative includes the widening and improvement of the existing route.

#### Road Concession for Electric Vehicles in Concepción Route 160



2024 Bidding call



**USD 200** million



13 km

The project considers the construction and maintenance of a centralized public transportation corridor between the Conexión con Puente Industrial – Enlace Junquillar and San Francisco (Coronel).

In addition, the project regularizes the level crossings with the railway, generates crosswalks, stops and projects three slopes that connect Route 160 with the coastal edge in the Michaihue, Carlos Pezoa Véliz and Escuadrón sectors, as well as a bicycle lane on the western side.







# **Roads** (7/10)

#### 2nd Road Concession Route 5 Rio Bueno - Puerto Montt



2024 Bidding call



USD 310 million



130 km

The project corresponds to the improvement of Route 5 between the communes of Río Bueno and Puerto Montt, with a length of approximately 129.8 km.

New works are planned, such as third lanes in some sectors, new junctions and improvements to existing ones, new turnings and crossings, replacement of existing bridges that have reached their useful life, geometric rectifications of the layout, new service roads and bicycle lanes, replacement and new walkways with their respective stops and pedestrian circuits, lighting, road safety works with the replacement of all the containment barriers to comply with the requirements of the current regulations, among others.

The initiative also considers the rehabilitation of existing pavements and the replacement of manual tolls to make way for an electronic toll collection system.

#### 2nd Road Concession Route 5 Collipulli - Temuco



2025 Bidding call



USD 320 million



144 km

The project corresponds to the re-bidding of the 144 km section of the current Route 5, which connects the cities of Collipulli and Temuco, in the Araucanía Region. The initiative considers the improvement, rehabilitation and conservation of the current dual carriageway, as well as the construction of third lanes in specific sectors linked to populated areas and higher safety and signaling standards. The project also includes new junctions, service roads, walkways and stops, and the incorporation of free-flow gantries.

Among the benefits of the project are the improvement of the road's safety standards, increased resistance to seismic movements and other natural hazards, and layout rectifications for a design speed of 120 km/hr.





# Roads (8/10)

#### Road Concession Valparaiso Peripheral



2025 Bidding call



USD 815 million



34 km

The project consists of the development of a new roadway for the Valparaíso Region, which will serve as an alternative, connecting Route 68 at the Las Cenizas junction with Concón in the vicinity of the Colmo Bridge on Route 64. This will create a new alternative semi-circumvallation to the east of Route 60-CH, Route 64 and Route F-30-E, with an approximate length of 34 kilometers that will be located in the municipalities of Valparaíso, Viña del Mar and Concón.

Additionally, the improvement of the main accesses to Valparaíso and Viña del Mar is being studied, as well as the possible creation of new accesses.

#### Road Concession Northwestern Orbital Santiago



2025 Bidding call



USD 987



66 km

The project considers the development of a new urban highway that will join the current Concession Acceso Nororiente a Santiago with Route 78 and with the future concession Orbital Sur Santiago, allowing to generate the western section of a new ring road around the city of Santiago.

It also includes the study of the feasibility of incorporating a new connection route with Route 5 (Liray Link) called "New North Connection Section".

The project considers the materialization of a dual carriageway with two or three lanes in each direction, with controlled accesses, service roads, junctions, footbridges, bridges, tunnels, among other works, with an approximate extension of 66 kilometers, located through the municipalities of Lampa, Pudahuel, Maipú, Padre Hurtado and Peñaflor in the Metropolitan Region.





# **Roads** (9/10)

#### Villarrica Roads Concession



2025 Bidding call



USD 608 million



86 km

The project consists of widening the roadway of the existing route and incorporating a new layout, with junctions, turns, crossings, service roads, walkways, stops and pedestrian sidewalks, lighting, road safety elements, among other works, to improve the level of service, the safety of the route and connectivity between the communes of Freire, Villarrica and Pucón. The route is divided into three sections. The first corresponds to Freire-Villarrica with a length of 48 km, then a bypass through the southwest of the city of Villarrica of 10 km and finally a new section Villarrica - Pucón.

#### L-30-M Route



2025 Bidding call



USD 600 million



83 km

The project involves improving Route L 30 M in the Maule Region, which begins at Route 5 in the San Javier area and ends at the urban limit of the Constitución commune, with an approximate length of 83 km.

The road is mainly used by cargo vehicles transporting forestry products, so improvements will be made to the route to facilitate transport and safety conditions.





# Chilean Concession System RoadS (10/10)

#### Road Concession Connection Copiulemu - Hualqui - Puerto Coronel



2026 <u>Bid</u>ding call



USD 134 million



40 km

The project consists of a new 40.3 km long highway that will connect Route O-50 (Concepción - Cabrero) with Route 160 (Coronel - Tres Pinos). The route starts in the town of Copiulemu and extends southwest, following Route 0-670, to the commune of Hualqui. Then it advances towards the north of this commune, crosses the Biobío River with a new bridge of approximately 1,800 meters long, to later cross the western zone of the Coastal Mountain Range, until it joins Route 160, in the sector of Cruce Calabozo in the Commune of Coronel.





# Airports (1/2)

#### Northern Airport Network (Andrés Sabella 3rd and Desierto de Atacama 2nd)

USD 316 million



48,000 m<sup>2</sup>

The project considers the expansion, repair, conservation and replacement of the infrastructure, equipment and pre-existing facilities of the Desierto de Atacama Airport and the Andrés Sabella Airport in the Antofagasta Region, with all the civil works and facilities necessary to provide airlines, passengers and other users with the service, comfort and safety conditions of an international airport.

#### 2nd Airport Concession Airport of Araucanía Region

22,276 m<sup>2</sup>

The project consists of the expansion, repair, conservation, and replacement of the existing infrastructure, equipment, and facilities of the Araucanía Region Airport, located in the municipality of Freire.

The future work seeks to meet the increased demand for flights to and from the area and to facilitate the transport of cargo and passengers, improving the airport's current capacity and service standards, as well as enhancing the economic and social integration of the region.


#### Airport Concession Network Tepual (5a), Cañal Bajo, Mocopulli y Pichoy

The initiative seeks to expand the capacity of these facilities for the benefit of the community of Los Lagos Region and to advance in strengthening the country's connectivity through an improved airport network.







# Transportation (1/3)

#### Cableway Concession Alto Hospicio - Iquique



2024 Bidding call



USD 108 million



6 Km

The project corresponds to the development of a cableway with an estimated extension of 5.5 km that will connect the stations of Los Cóndores, in the commune of Alto Hospicio, and Rotonda El Pampino, in the city of Iquique.

The project proposes a new non-polluting public transportation system with a maximum capacity of 3,000 passengers per hour in each direction.

Among the benefits of the future project is that it will reduce travel times between the two localities, since it is estimated that the section will be traveled in 16 minutes.

#### Coquimbo - La Serena Connectivity via Public Transportation



2025 Bidding call



USD 313 million



14 Km

The project corresponds to a new type of public transportation, which considers a light electric tram-type vehicle that will improve the connectivity of the Coquimbo-La Serena conurbation. The selected route connects the center of Coquimbo (Plaza 11 Septiembre in front of the Hospital) and the center of La Serena, with an approximate extension of 13.7 km. and 19 stations.

The work will reduce travel times and thus facilitate the movement of the inhabitants of both cities and other neighboring areas that need to travel between the two communes.





# Transportation (2/3)

#### Cableway Concession Valparaíso



2025 Bidding call



USD 78 million



The project consists on the construction, operation and maintenance of a cableway system in Valparaíso, which will connect the highland sectors and the city plan with the existing public transportation network, such as the Metro of Valparaíso.

The initiative seeks to facilitate the transportation of those who live in the hills and must travel on a daily basis. The cableway will increase the tourist attraction of the city, generating new poles of attraction around the stations, and will offer a transportation alternative to decongest the commune.

#### 2nd Land Port Concession Los Andes



2025 Bidding call



USD 56 million



60,000 m<sup>2</sup>

The project consists of the expansion and improvement of the current land port, located in the Sauce sector, in the commune of Los Andes, Valparaíso Region, which originally had an area of approximately 24 hectares, plus a truck parking area.

The project considers incorporating a technological improvement in the logistic and revision processes of the cargo entering and leaving the country through the Los Libertadores border crossing, which connects Chile with Argentina and the rest of Mercosur, in order to speed up the cargo revision and release processes, The aim is to minimize the impact on the roads in the areas surrounding its location, improving security in the area and reducing the time it takes to transport products to their final destination, thus favoring the logistics chain related to productive activities in the central part of the country.





# Transportation (3/3)

#### Tram Concession Pajaritos - Airport of Santiago AMB



2026 Bidding call



USD 398 million



12 Km

The project proposes a new kind of public transportation that includes a light electric tram-type vehicle that will facilitate access to the Arturo Merino Benítez International Airport. This will provide the country's main airport with an expeditious, sustainable, safe and quality connectivity with the city of Santiago, as well as benefiting the districts of Pudahuel, Lo Prado, Cerro Navia and Estación Central, by improving local connectivity.

The work contemplates a length of 12 km and will connect the Metro station Pajaritos of Line 1 and Barrancas of Line 5 with the Santiago Airport.

#### Tram Concession Viña del Mar - Reñaca

The project considers the construction and operation of a new mass public transport tramway that will connect the city of Viña del Mar with Reñaca. Initially, the initiative proposes the operation of two lines located along the waterfront, on which 30-meter-long streetcars will run, with five modules and a capacity for 200 passengers.

The project under evaluation considers a frequency of two minutes during rush hour, which will allow around 9,000 trips to be made during rush hour. The above seeks to generate a positive impact on the communes of Viña del Mar and Concón by providing a new non-polluting transportation alternative that will reduce travel times and traffic congestion.

The initiative proposes a seawater desalination service using the reverse osmosis system, with an estimated production capacity of 1,200 liters/second, including the works for the intake system to feed the plant, brine discharge outfall, pre-filtration systems, as well as the works for the piping and pumping system to an 8,000 m<sup>3</sup> drinking water distribution tank, preliminarily located about 21 km from the plant.






