The World Economic Forum, with the International Business Council, worked with the Big Four to build a list of ESG metrics every company should be able to report against.



1. Strategise

Establish a sustainable ESG strategy that positively impacts the environment and society whilst driving shareholder value

3. Finance

Evaluate your funding sources and any lending activity against green financing solutions. Find the data and engage ESG rating providers to ensure your business is correctly rated



5. Measure and Report

Align governance and remuneration to green transformation and relentlessly measure and report progress against ESG factors



2. Evaluate

Examine current business and operating model through the lens of ESG, identifying threats and opportunities



4. Transform

Define and design the desired future of your business and operating model and start the journey of transformation

Governance

Strategy

The actual and potential impacts of climaterelated risks and opportunities on the organisation's businesses, strategy, and financial planning.

Risk Management

The processes used by the organisation to identify, asses, and manage climate-related risks.

Metrics and Targets

The metrics and targets used to assess and manage relevant climate-relate risks and opportunities.
