Who we are

KPMG is a multi-national company and one of the 'Big Four' accounting organisations. Our name stands for Klynveld Peat Marwick Goerdeler... but we don't expect you to remember that.

We employ more than 260,000 people across 150 countries. As a global organisation our network is made up of individual businesses across the world – called member firms – that all operate under the KPMG banner. Locally, we're known as KPMG in the Crown Dependencies.

Our name comes from when KPMG in the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man combined in 2021 to become one member firm. We now employ more than 500 people across Guernsey, Jersey and the Isle of Man. We hope you might be keen to learn more about our KPMG family, as the business continues to grow within our beloved Crown Dependency islands.

What we do

It's easy to sum us up as an accountancy firm, but we are so much more than that.

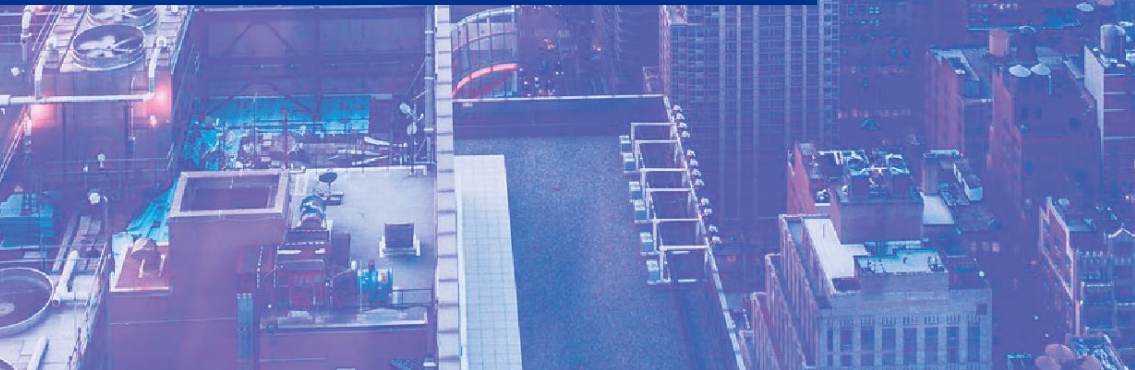

Our staff are all super friendly and always available to help. Games of pool or Mario Kart frequently take place in the staff room during moments of downtime.

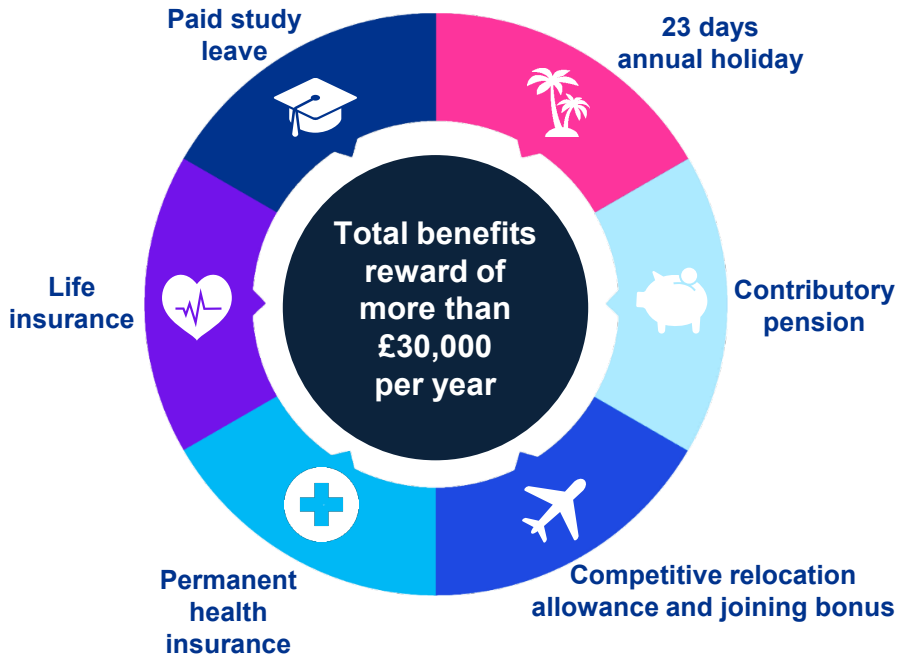
The best workplaces are where you work with your friends, and many of our colleagues make their friends for life at KPMG – organising their own Christmas and Summer parties for everyone to enjoy.
