# Restrictions from 11 November 2020

The Hungarian Government, in order to curb the spread of a COVID-19 pandemic, introduces the following restrictions from 11 November 2020:



MASK USE



- everybody is required to use a mask except children under 6 years when:
  - ✓ using public transport or waiting for the means of transport;
  - ✓ in public spaces appointed by the local municipality with a population over 10 000 inhabitants;
  - ✓ in shops or public institutions;
  - ✓ in restaurants;
  - ✓ in healthcare or social institutions

- ✓ commercial activity may be conducted based on contracts concluded with restaurants and shops merchandizing **daily consumer goods**;
- ✓ delivery service may be conducted **without any notification or registration**

# Restrictions from 11 November 2020

The Hungarian Government, in order to curb the spread of a COVID-19 pandemic, introduces the following restrictions from 11 November 2020:



## CURFEW



- curfew will be in effect between 8 p.m. and 5.a.m except for
  - ✓ commuting to or from work, that also needs to be certified;
  - ✓ participating in tranings or sport events in case of competitive athletes
  - ✓ walking dogs within 500 meter of home;
  - ✓ in extraordinary cases;
- all forms of assembly is prohibited

- leisure facilities (e.g.: fitness room, museum, theatre, zoo) shall be closed;
- holding events are generally prohibited;
- 10 people as a maximum may take part in family gatherings and private events;
- weddings may be held only without a reception, in church and civil ceremony only those persons may participate whose presence is necessary for the ceremony, such as witnesses, parents, grandparents, siblings and children;
- in funerals, maximum 50 person may be attended

The Hungarian Government, in order to curb the spread of a COVID-19 pandemic, introduces the following restrictions from 11 November 2020:



## OPENING TIME/ CLOSING TIME



- the restaurants shall be closed, only home delivery or take-away is permitted, canteens and buffets of factories, hotels, healthcare and educational institutions may remain open;
- shops may be open until 7 p.m, except: drugstores, petrol stations;
- other services shall operate on the usual schedule (e.g.: hairdressers);
- hotels may host only guests arriving for business or educational purposes, they may not host tourists;
- leisure facilities shall be closed

- sports matches can be held behind closed gates;
- while individual outdoor sporting activities are permitted, taking part in amateur team sport is prohibited;
- sports facilities are open to competitive athletes for training or sporting events

## EDUCATION



- higher education may operate only online, colleges, higher education colleges shall be closed;
- in secondary schools above 8th grade, digital education shall be in effect;
- nurseries, kindergartens, primary schools for children under age 14 remain open

- hospital workers, school teachers, kindergarten's and nursery's workers should be tested on a weekly basis

## THE EFFECT OF RESTRICTIONS



- The Government introduces the restrictions for 30 days.
- The restrictions came into effect on 11 November 2020.
- The Parliament authorized the Government for a maximum of 90 days to prolong the effect of government decrees made during the state of emergency.
