# Ritinjali

Ritinjali is one of our partner NGOs based in Delhi. It is committed to ensuring that all children, irrespective of gender and social strata, have access to education.

KPMG Global Services Pvt Ltd (KGSPL) supports batches of current students and few alums at Ritinjali's Second Chance School, which is a residential and day-school program for disadvantaged boys between 18 and 24 years. The transformational program aims to reintegrate young adults into social and work life in a secure, loving and stimulating environment.

It is a unique and dynamic school catering to the needs of young adults coming from challenging backgrounds during which they have faced poverty, exploitation and discrimination. It focuses on the Life Skills program through classroom training in the first half of the year and on technical education, entrepreneurship training & mentorship, internship, placement etc. in the second half.





# Saahas

Saahas is a not-for-profit organization committed to providing holistic and scientific solutions to responsibly manage municipal solid waste.

KG SPL will be working with Saahas to address the problem of biodegradable waste through a decentralized circular solution — biogas plant (Capacity of 2TPD) — to produce clean fuel for kitchens in public universities/community kitchen.

We will showcase biogas as an effective decentralized solution for biodegradable waste, and parallelly capturing carbon credit generated. Set up a plant of 2 tons per day capacity at a host site, which has a kitchen/canteen for community, e.g., public university/government hospital/community kitchen.

Additionally, our colleagues will create awareness among children to influence the next generation. We are working with several schools/educational institutions on solid waste and driving behavioral change in line with the 3R principles for systematic waste reduction and management considering the environmental concerns.

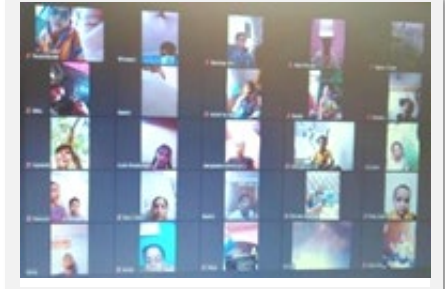


# Literacy India

Literacy India (LI) is one of our partner NGOs operating from Gurugram. LI focuses on educating underprivileged women and children and empowering them to become self reliant and employable.

KGSPL supports their project Vidyapeeth, which is being run out of a school based in village Bajghera, Gurugram. The school supports students from nearby underprivileged communities. They run classes up to high school.

We provide the salaries of few teachers for better learning outcomes and quality engagement. The success of Vidyapeeth depends largely on the quality of teachers and their ability to keep the children engaged.



# Sshrishti

Sshrishti is our partner NGO in Uttarakhand. KG SPL actively supports Sshrishti's Community Resource Network (CRN) learning centers in Uttarakhand where they provide online education to school students and young adults in remote villages.

The centers provide support to students who are enrolled for computer classes and for remedial classes for spoken English, mathematics, etc. We endeavor to help improve academic, linguistic and digital proficiency of the students at the different centers. The focus is to help increase the knowledge levels of basic subjects to provide a strong foundation for advanced learning and practical application.





# The/Nudge Foundation

The/Nudge Foundation is one of our Partner NGOs based in Bengaluru. It focuses on sustainable poverty alleviation by building a strong 360-degree life, learning and economic foundation that equips them to escape the cycle of poverty.

KG SPL supports the ultra-poor project in Jharkhand. The main objective of the 36-month micro-entrepreneurship program is to work with women-led ultra-poor families in Jharkhand and help develop their skills in diversified livelihoods such as agriculture, livestock and small trade.

In addition, wherever possible, we aim to help them build kitchen gardens that can be used to meet their family's nutritional requirements as well as generate some income. We are working with the Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG) communities in the districts of Lohardaga, Latehar and Gumla.



# The/Nudge Foundation

## Setting up of Project Management Units (PMU)

Apart from support to continue the livelihoods of *didis*, KGSPL is also supporting the formation of a Project Management Unit (PMU) with the objective to realize the National Rural Livelihood Mission's (NRLM) — a Government of India's flagship program to eradicate rural poverty — vision to alleviate ultra-poverty (here on referred to as poorest of the poor) by helping develop a national strategy, design and guideline by way of targeting the poorest of the poor through the graduation approach adapted to and built on top of community institutions.

The PMUs would provide timely and higher order technical assistance for implementation of the Graduation Approach and capacity building support to SRLM and Community Based Organizations (CBOs) in the development of the poorest or the poor.

With setting up of the PMUs, we hope to expand the scope of the poverty alleviation work that we have been supporting in the three districts of Jharkhand to a wider national level.



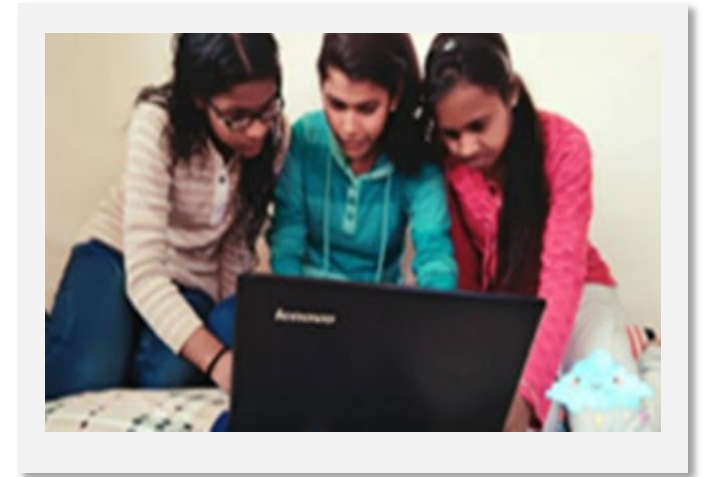


# NavGurukul

NavGurukul runs a one-year residential course for young women from underserved and diverse communities. Students after pursuing their course are awarded a Diploma in Software Programming issued by the Directorate General of Training, Government of India.

NavGurukul's focus area is to provide higher education linked strongly to the employability of the marginalized so that they can have access to aspirational jobs like Software Engineering and Analytics. Higher education of the marginalized doesn't just help these students, but it also creates problem solvers within the communities. The residential program enables them to become financially comfortable, equips them with confidence and provides practical exposure to solve real-world problems.

KG SPL has partnered with NavGurukul on a 15-month project spread over two years to set up the Bengaluru campus that will house girl students from different parts of India. This will help the youth, especially women, gain access to aspirational careers that would have otherwise been difficult to achieve.



# Sportz Village Foundation

Sportz Village Foundation (SVF), India's number one sports education organization, believes that playing sports is an integral part of a child's education. This aligns perfectly with our belief that a child's holistic development is not complete without the inclusion of physical activity. We have already been working towards improving the quality of education, nutrition, skill development, honing the entrepreneurial mindset in students and integrating SVF's pioneering scientifically researched and highly tested Sport for Change program is an excellent way to ensure well-rounded development and empowerment of children from underserved communities.

We will execute this program in few govt. schools and engage with students from middle grades. We will also run an after-school academy for few exceptionally talented children and offer them the opportunity to participate in district/state-level tournaments.

KG SPL colleagues can also volunteer to support children in ongoing sports training sessions and events etc.

KG SPL supports skill development, remedial classes, extracurricular activities, scholarships and nutrition for children and youths residing within the Don Bosco campus.

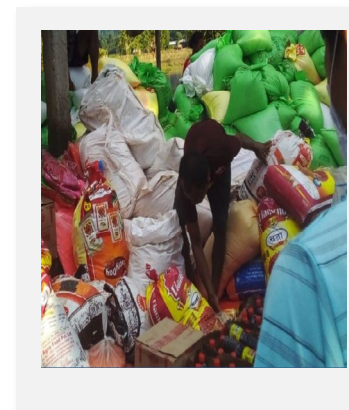
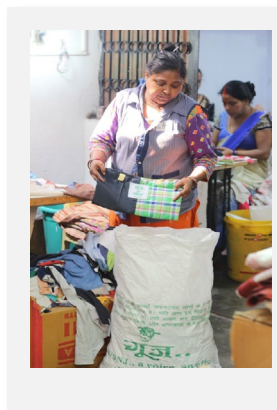


# Goonj

The NGO Goonj has been working extensively across urban and rural parts of 25 states and union territories of India. It has a strong network of a few hundred grassroots partner organizations and hundreds of corporate and institutional partners in cities and does large-scale disaster relief and rehabilitation work across India.

With the support from KGSPL, Goonj provided relief and rehabilitation to the flood-affected districts of Assam under their Cloth for Work initiative. Under this, the community members of different districts took part in rehabilitation work such as cleaning and beautification of villages and ponds, repairing roads, building community spaces and rebuilding damaged infrastructure like bridges.

Family relief kits distribution: KGSPL, in partnership with Goonj, managed to provide immediate relief and distribute family relief kits in the worst-affected districts of Assam. The family relief kits included dry ration along with hygiene essentials like toiletries and cleaning items, mosquito nets, tarpaulins, sanitary napkins, blankets, etc.



# Team Everest

Team Everest (TE) is one of the biggest youth-run NGOs in India. They have over 25,000 volunteers focused on motivating individuals to volunteer at least once a month and make a difference by providing quality education to financially challenged children.

KGSPL has partnered with TE to support the mentorship and skill development program for school and college students. The NGO conducted various initiatives throughout the year for the beneficiaries where KGSPL colleagues volunteered.





# Bhumi

Bhumi is a Tamil Nadu-based NGO, which is working towards providing holistic education and enabling sustainable livelihoods for 5,000 children.

KG SPL, in partnership with Bhumi, is focused on educating children on the importance of environmental sustainability.

Colleagues can volunteer in engagement projects for the children to raise awareness on environmental conservation.

ConnectFor offers an exclusively curated virtual volunteering program. Their priority is to continue their efforts to help with capacity building and the daily administration of organizations such as day-schools, hospitals and shelter homes.
