

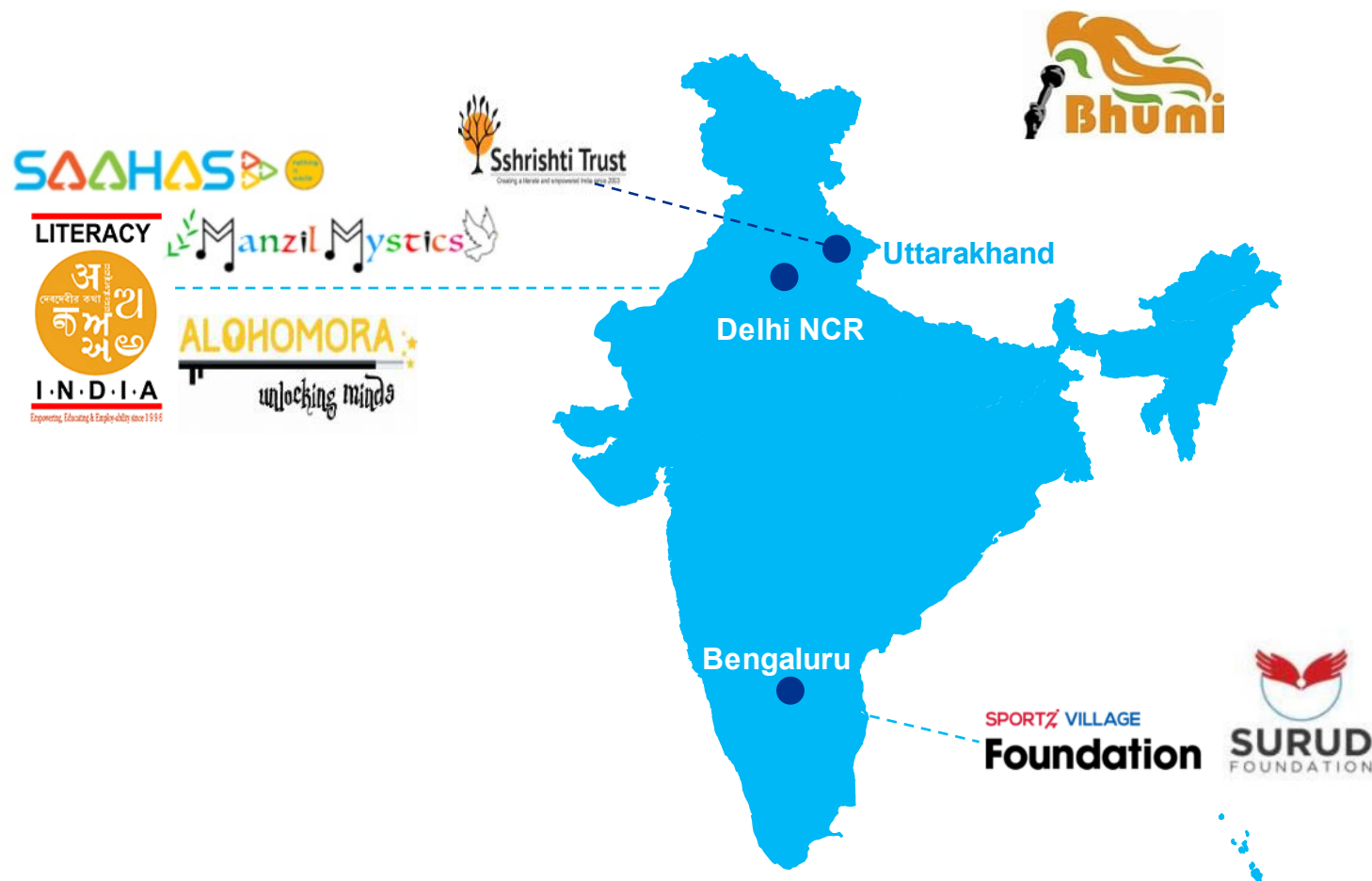


NGOs we support

We currently fund eight NGOs across India



Literacy India

Literacy India (LI) is one of our partner NGOs operating from Gurugram. LI focuses on educating underprivileged women and children and empowering them to become self reliant and employable.

KPMG Resource Centre Private Limited (KRCPL) supports their project Vidyapeeth, which is being run out of a school based in village Bajghera, Gurugram. The school supports students from nearby underprivileged communities. They run classes up to high school.

KRCPL also supports the mid-day meal program for their students. This program helps prevent malnutrition, increases classroom enrolment and retention, improves student participation and concentration and reduces dropout rates.

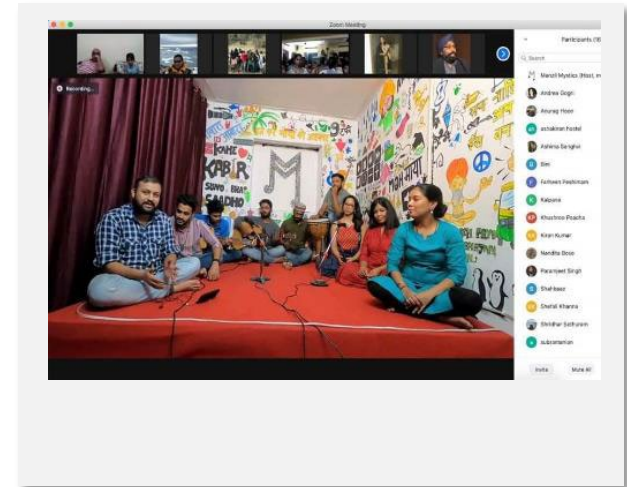
However, since schools were closed this year due to the pandemic, we distributed grocery kits including essential nutritious items for the students instead.



Manzil Mystics

We support a music program for children of our partner NGO Manzil Mystics. Through music, we intend to teach children how to express their hopes, feelings, ideas, happiness, anger and frustration.

The activities are designed to be fun and creative, and many times we extend them to incorporate lessons of reading, writing, speaking English, values, social & life skills, menstrual hygiene, reproductive health and gender education.

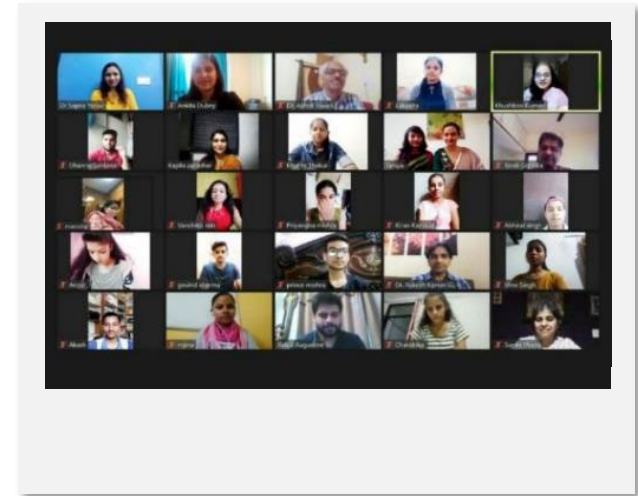


Alohomora

We partner with the NGO Alohomora who work with the Delhi Government on an Entrepreneurship Mindset Curriculum (EMC) program, to instill an entrepreneurial outlook in young students. It has been developed by SCERT Delhi with help from teachers and NGOs and focuses on providing real-life experiences to students between grade 9 and 12 that can help them become responsible professionals.

Alohomora provides strategic support to SCERT and the EMC team, organizes live sessions with entrepreneurs from different fields and runs student-led projects for exploring different career paths including starting their own businesses.

KRCPL also supports the Desh ke Mentor program that enables mentors and mentees to connect through a state-of-the-art mobile application. Mentors can choose any number of mentees and guide them through lessons on time management, communication, handling exam pressure, building and entrepreneurial mindset and much more.



Saahas

Saahas is a not-for-profit organization committed to providing holistic and scientific solutions to responsibly manage municipal solid waste.

KRCPL will be working with Saahas to address the problem of biodegradable waste through a decentralized circular solution - biogas plant (Capacity of 2TPD) - to produce clean fuel for kitchens in public universities/community kitchen.

We will showcase biogas as an effective decentralized solution for biodegradable waste, and parallelly capturing carbon credit generated. Set up a plant of 2 tons per day capacity at a host site, which has a kitchen/canteen for community, e.g., public university/government hospital/community kitchen.

Additionally, our colleagues will create awareness among children to influence the next generation. We are working with several schools/educational institutions on solid waste and driving behavioral change in line with the 3R principles for systematic waste reduction and management considering the environmental concerns.



Sshrishti

Sshrishti is our partner NGO in Uttarakhand. KRCPL actively supports Sshrishti's Community Resource Network (CRN) learning centers in Uttarakhand where they provide online education to school students and young adults in remote villages.

The centers provide support to students who are enrolled for computer classes and for remedial classes for spoken English, mathematics, etc. We endeavor to help improve academic, linguistic and digital proficiency of the students at the different centers. The focus is to help increase the knowledge levels of basic subjects to provide a strong foundation for advanced learning and practical application.



Sportz Village Foundation

Sportz Village Foundation (SVF), India's number one sports education organization, believes that playing sports is an integral part of a child's education. This aligns perfectly with our belief that a child's holistic development is not complete without the inclusion of physical activity. We have already been working towards improving the quality of education, nutrition, skill development, honing the entrepreneurial mindset in students and integrating SVF's pioneering scientifically researched and highly tested Sport for Change program is an excellent way to ensure well-rounded development and empowerment of children from underserved communities.

KRCPL will execute this program in few govt. schools and engage with students from middle grades. We will also run an after-school academy for few exceptionally talented children and offer them the opportunity to participate in district/state-level tournaments.

Colleagues can also volunteer to support children in ongoing sports training sessions and events etc.

Surud Foundation

Surud Foundation is a purpose-driven social organization working towards elimination of poverty, hunger and road accidents. They are also aimed at improving education, skill development, entrepreneurship etc.

KRCPL has partnered with Surud Foundation to implement projects focusing on environmental sustainability.

Our colleagues can volunteer to participate in a range of activities such as making seedballs/seed-bombs, educating children on waste management and crop cultivation by setting up a composting plant and kitchen gardens in government schools.



Bhumi

Bhumi is a Tamil Nadu-based NGO, which is working towards providing holistic education and enabling sustainable livelihoods for 5,000 children.

KRCPL, in partnership with Bhumi, is focused on educating children on the importance of environmental sustainability.

Colleagues can volunteer in engagement projects for the children to raise awareness on environmental conservation.
