




ENRich Voices and Thought Leadership

Voices

The reality of climate change and its far reaching impacts are visible to all. As energy transition becomes more than a buzz word and organizations play catch up, it is increasingly clear that our governments and our education and research institutions will need to partner with industry on driving change.

"Voices" will carry cross-generational views on the issues involved in making change happen. Thought Leadership

ENRich 2023 will see the launch of our thought leadership on "Energy Transition – Pivoting towards global leadership in manufacturing".

The global energy transition is in full swing, with India emerging as a central figure driving progress. However, recent supply shocks, global market imbalances, and geopolitical tensions have led to a global reevaluation of the current renewable energy (RE) supply chain paradigm. India, with strong captive demand for RE equipment coupled with unique domestic characteristics, is well positioned to capitalize on the manufacturing opportunity this reevaluation presents and emerge as a manufacturing hub.

Fulfilling this potential will require a number of imperatives to be addressed across the manufacturing value chain. Upstream activities such as raw material extraction and processing, and downstream activities such as end-of-life management and circularity will also key roles in ensuring sectoral development. Industry 4.0 and other digital technologies will need to be leveraged to remain at the cutting edge of manufacturing. Skill development and fostering of a collaborative innovation ecosystem will serve as critical enablers for long term viability. These imperatives will also alter the job landscape in the country, with new roles emerging as capacities develop.

This thought leadership will bring opinions from multiple KPMG sectoral experts to bear on one of the most critical issues within the energy transition today. We believe that this work will paint a clear picture of India's RE manufacturing landscape leading up to 2030, and beyond.
