# We currently fund six NGOs across India



NavGurukul runs a residential course for young women from underserved and diverse communities. Students are awarded a Diploma in Software Programming issued by the Directorate General of Training, Government of India on successful completion of the course.

NavGurukul's focus is to provide higher education linked strongly to the employability of the marginalized so that they can have access to aspirational jobs like Software Engineering and Analytics. Higher education of the marginalized doesn't just help these students, but it also creates problem solvers within the communities. The residential program enables them to become financially comfortable, equips them with confidence and provides practical exposure to solve real-world problems.

KPMG Global Delivery Center Private Limited (GDCPL) has partnered with NavGurukul to set up a Bengaluru campus for girl students from different parts of India. This will help the youth, especially women, gain access to aspirational careers that would have otherwise been difficult to achieve.

Today, U&I is operational in 39 cities across India, impacting 2,000+ children through its U&I Teach initiative.

MGDS is working in the deltaic region of the Sundarbans and other parts of West Bengal for over a decade.

# The/Nudge Lifeskills Foundation



The/Nudge Lifeskills Foundation is one of our partner NGOs based in Bengaluru. It focuses on sustainable poverty alleviation by building a strong 360-degree life, learning and economic foundation that equips the ultra-poor to escape the cycle of poverty.

GDCPL supports the End Ultra-Poverty Program in three districts of Jharkhand – Lohardaga, Latehar and Gumla. The main objective of the program is to work with women belonging to families of the ultra-poor population in Jharkhand and help develop their livelihood skills such as agriculture, livestock and small trade. In addition, wherever possible, we aim to help them build kitchen gardens that can be used to meet their family's nutritional requirements as well as generate some income.



# Jharkhand

Bhumi is a Tamil Nadu-based NGO, which is working towards providing holistic education and enabling sustainable livelihoods for 5,000 children.

GDCPL, in partnership with Bhumi, is focused on educating children on the importance of environmental sustainability. The NGO organizes and executes several eco-friendly initiatives such as making seed balls, crafting art object with seeds embedded in them and much more.

Colleagues volunteer in engagement projects for the children to raise awareness on environmental conservation and sustainable change.
