

#### **Ritinjali**



Ritinjali is one of our partner NGOs based in Delhi. It is committed to ensuring that all children, irrespective of gender and social strata, have access to education.

KPMG Global Services Pvt Ltd (KGSPL) supports batches of current students and few alums at Ritinjali's Second Chance School (SCS). SCS is a two-year residential and day school program for disadvantaged boys between 18–24 years of age who did not get a first chance at education. The students are enrolled from across the country. The program includes educational skills, vocational skills, development of life skills, social values, communication skills, spoken English, technology and multimedia literacy.

This program focuses on developing life skills through classroom training in the first half of the year and on technical education, entrepreneurship training and mentorship, internship and placement in the second half of the year.













#### Saahas



Saahas is a not-for-profit organization committed to providing holistic and scientific solutions to responsibly manage municipal solid waste.

KGSPL is working with Saahas to address the problem of biodegradable waste through a decentralized circular solution — biogas plant with a capacity of 2 tons per day (TPD) — to produce clean fuel for municipal corporation-run community kitchens that provide mid-day meals to various schools in Delhi.

We will showcase biogas as an effective decentralized solution for biodegradable waste, and parallelly capturing carbon credit generated. We are working toward setting up a 2TPD-capacity plant at a host site, which has a community kitchen that provides mid-day meals for students in various schools in Delhi.

Additionally, our colleagues organize awareness sessions at several government/NGO-run schools on solid waste, driving behavioral change in line with the 3R principles for systematic waste reduction and management considering the environmental concerns.









#### **Literacy India**



Literacy India (LI) is one of our partner NGOs operating from Gurugram. LI focuses on educating underprivileged women and children and empowering them to become self reliant and employable.

KGSPL supports the education of 200 students from LI's project Vidyapeeth, which operates out of a school based in village Bajghera, Gurugram. The support covers teachers' salary, school uniform, books, stationery, utilities, etc.

The success of Vidyapeeth depends largely on the quality of teachers and their ability to keep the children engaged.















#### **Sportz Village Foundation**



Sportz Village Foundation (SVF), India's number one sports education organization, believes that playing sports is an integral part of a child's education. This aligns perfectly with our belief that a child's holistic development is not complete without the inclusion of physical activity. We have already been working toward improving the quality of education, nutrition, skill development, honing the entrepreneurial mindset in students and integrating SVF's pioneering scientifically researched and highly tested Sport for Change program is an excellent way to ensure well-rounded development and empowerment of children from underserved communities.

We are running this program in six government schools in Bengaluru and two government schools in Gurugram. We are also running an after-school academy for few exceptionally talented children and offer them the opportunity to participate in district/state-level tournaments.

#### Sshrishti



Sshrishti is our partner NGO in Uttarakhand. KGSPL actively supports Sshrishti's Community Resource Network (CRN) learning centers in Uttarakhand where they provide online education to school students and young adults in remote villages.

The centers provide support to students who are enrolled for computer classes and for remedial classes for spoken English, mathematics, etc. We endeavor to help improve academic, linguistic and digital proficiency of the students at the different centers. The focus is to help increase the knowledge levels of basic subjects to provide a strong foundation for advanced learning and practical application.

### Goonj



KGSPL supports the NGO Goonj in providing disaster relief and rehabilitation provisions across India. This year, we supported their relief and rehabilitation efforts in Himachal Pradesh and other adjoining areas which were severely affected by heavy rains, floods and landslides in 2023.

Goonj provided family relief kits to the most affected individuals and families. While the kits were customized per the affected area's local needs, some more significant components included standard items such as dry rations, blankets, footwear, winter essentials, hygiene essentials, dari, towels and tarpaulins. These kits addressed the immediate needs of the affected communities. To avoid duplication, items were added to or removed from the kits after considering the relief material that were already being provided by other relief agencies working in the same space.

#### The/Nudge Lifeskills Foundation



Setting up of Project Management Units (PMU)

KGSPL is supporting the formation of a Project Management Unit (PMU) with the objective to realize the National Rural Livelihood Mission's (NRLM) — a Government of India's flagship program to eradicate rural poverty — vision to alleviate ultra-poverty (here on referred to as poorest of the poor) by helping develop a national strategy, design and guideline by way of targeting the poorest of the poor through the graduation approach adapted to and built on top of community institutions.

The PMUs would provide timely and higher order technical assistance for implementation of the Graduation Approach and capacity building support to SRLM and Community Based Organizations (CBOs) in the development of the poorest or the poor.

With setting up of the PMUs, both at Jharkhand state as well as at the central government level, we hope to expand the scope of poverty alleviation work that we have been supporting in the three districts of Jharkhand to a wider national level.









#### The/Nudge Lifeskills Foundation



Capacity building of non-profit organizations

KGSPL is supporting the capacity building of non-profit organizations from The/Nudge Incubator and Accelerator cohorts to undertake charitable activities toward poverty alleviation.

The Atal Incubation Centre (AIC NCore Developmental Impact Foundation | abbrev: AIC NCore) is a special-purpose vehicle set up in partnership with NITI Ayog. The/Nudge Lifeskills Foundation (NLF), along with AIC NCore, will work towards the implementation of this program.

KGSPL will provide the resources to build capacities of these incubators through various interventions.









#### **Mukti Green Defense System**

Mukti Green Defense System (MGDS) is one of our NGO partners focused on ensuring that workers and communities are not left behind as the world transitions toward a cleaner and more resilient future. MGDS is working in the deltaic region of the Sundarbans and other parts of West Bengal for over a decade.

KGSPL is supporting the NGO's efforts toward conserving mangroves in the deltaic region to build a climate resilient community. The initiative aims to protect the Sundarbans from river embankment erosion while promoting sustainable practices and enhancing local ecosystems.

Through the program's multi-tiered approach, we aim to facilitate long-lasting environmental benefits, create sustainable economic opportunities and drive social empowerment for the local communities.







#### **NavGurukul**



NavGurukul runs a residential course for young women from underserved and diverse communities. Students after pursuing their course are awarded a Diploma in Software Programming issued by the Directorate General of Training, Government of India.

NavGurukul's focus area is to provide higher education linked strongly to the employability of the marginalized so that they can have access to aspirational jobs like Software Engineering and Analytics. Higher education of the marginalized youth doesn't just help these students, but it also creates problem solvers within the communities. The residential program enables them to become financially comfortable, equips them with confidence and provides practical exposure to solve real-world problems.

KGSPL has partnered with NavGurukul on an 18-month project spread over two years to set up the Bengaluru campus that will house girl students from different parts of India. This will help the youth, especially women, gain access to aspirational careers that would have otherwise been difficult to achieve.









#### Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled

The Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled is one of our NGO partners who are working extensively toward empowering persons with disabilities gain access to quality education and sustainable employment.

KGSPL will support the three-month residential skilling program for youth with disabilities coming from marginalized sections of the society. This program is designed to provide livelihood skilling, personality development, language skills, career guidance, skilling support, and most importantly placement support and follow up at the workplace.

Through this, we aim to ensure that the youth achieve self-sufficiency through employment or self-employment. Our goal is to empower the youth to become socially and economically independent and enable them to break free of the disability related social stigma.

The program will run in three locations: Kochi (Kerala), Guntur (Andhra Pradesh) and Bellary (Karnataka).







#### **Don Bosco India**



Don Bosco is a Kochi-based NGO that reaches out to and rescues children and at-risk youth with an objective to protect, educate rehabilitate and inspire them towards realizing their full potential.

KGSPL supports scholarships for higher education pursued by disadvantaged youth to secure a future in gaining meaningful employment.







#### The Humsafar Trust

Founded in 1994, The Humsafar Trust (HST) actively works on the health and human rights of the LGBTQ+ community.

HST is also actively working toward addressing the challenges faced by transgender individuals in accessing quality education, healthcare, sustainable livelihoods and economic empowerment.

KGSPL supports HST's comprehensive Transgender Entrepreneurship Programs, which aims to empower and support transgender individuals from underprivileged backgrounds in establishing and growing their own businesses. By creating an inclusive and enabling environment, this program seeks to overcome the barriers that transgender entrepreneurs face and promote their economic self-sufficiency and social integration.







#### **Team Everest**



Team Everest (TE) is one of the biggest youth-run NGOs in India. They have over 25,000 volunteers focused on motivating individuals to volunteer at least once a month and make a difference by providing quality education to financially challenged children.

KGSPL has partnered with TE to support the mentorship and skill development program for school and college students. The NGO conducted various initiatives throughout the year for the beneficiaries where KGSPL colleagues volunteered.







#### Bhumi



Bhumi is a Tamil Nadu-based NGO, which is working towards providing holistic education and enabling sustainable livelihoods for children from underserved sections of the society.

KGSPL supports Bhumi's "knowledge and skill development programme" for school and college students.

Colleagues volunteer in engagement activities and interact with beneficiaries throughout the year.
