

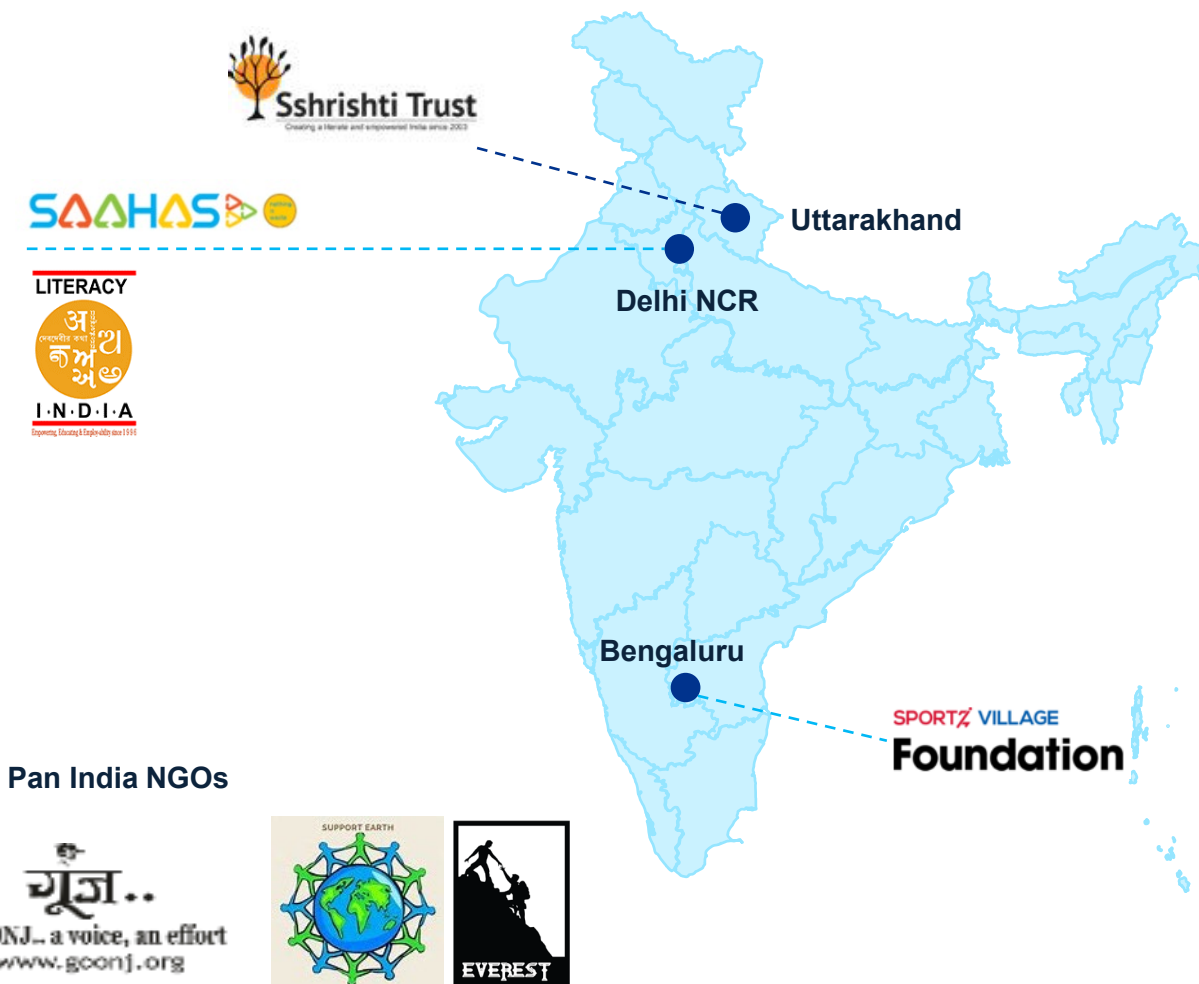


NGOs we support

Literacy India



Literacy India (LI) is one of our partner NGOs operating from Gurugram. LI focuses on educating underprivileged women and children and empowering them to become self-reliant and employable.

KPMG Resource Centre Private Limited (KRCPL) supports the mid-day meal program for their students at the school based in village Bajghera, Gurugram. This program helps prevent malnutrition, increases classroom enrolment and retention, improves student participation and concentration and reduces dropout rates.

The school supports students from nearby underprivileged communities. They run classes up to high school.

Sportz Village Foundation



Sportz Village Foundation (SVF), India's number one sports education organization, believes that playing sports is an integral part of a child's education. This aligns perfectly with our belief that a child's holistic development is not complete without the inclusion of physical activity. We have already been working toward improving the quality of education, nutrition, skill development, honing the entrepreneurial mindset in students and integrating SVF's pioneering scientifically researched and highly tested Sport for Change program is an excellent way to ensure a well-rounded development and empowerment of children from underserved communities.

We are running this program in six government schools in Bengaluru and two government schools in Gurugram. We are also running an after-school academy for few exceptionally talented children and offer them the opportunity to participate in district/state-level tournaments.



Gurugram & Bengaluru

Saahas is a not-for-profit organization committed to providing holistic and scientific solutions to responsibly manage municipal solid waste.

KRCPL is working with Saahas to address the problem of biodegradable waste through a decentralized circular solution — biogas plant with a capacity of 2 tons per day (TPD) — to produce clean for municipal corporation-run community kitchens that provide mid-day meals to various schools in Delhi.

We will showcase biogas as an effective decentralized solution for biodegradable waste, and parallelly capturing carbon credit generated. We are working toward setting up a 2TPD-capacity plant at a host site, which has a community kitchen that provides mid-day meals for students in various schools in Delhi.

Additionally, our colleagues organize awareness sessions at several government/NGO-run schools on solid waste, driving behavioral change in line with the 3R principles for systematic waste reduction and management considering the environmental concerns.



Delhi

Sshrishti is our partner NGO in Uttarakhand. KRCPL actively supports Sshrishti's Community Resource Network (CRN) learning centers in Uttarakhand where they provide online education to school students and young adults in remote villages.

The centers provide support to students who are enrolled for computer classes and for remedial classes for spoken English, mathematics, etc. We aim to help improve academic, linguistic and digital proficiency of the students at the different centers. The focus is to help increase the knowledge levels of basic subjects to provide a strong foundation for advanced learning and practical application.



Uttarakhand

KRCPL supports the NGO Goonj in providing disaster relief and rehabilitation provisions across India. This year, we supported their relief and rehabilitation efforts in Himachal Pradesh and other adjoining areas which were severely affected by heavy rains, floods and landslides in 2023.

Goonj provided family relief kits to the most affected individuals and families. While the kits were customized per the affected area's local needs, some more significant components included standard items such as dry rations, blankets, footwear, winter essentials, hygiene essentials, *dari*, towels and tarpaulins. These kits addressed the immediate needs of the affected communities. To avoid duplication, items were added to or removed from the kits after considering the relief material that were already being provided by other relief agencies working in the same space.



Himachal Pradesh

Team Everest



Team Everest (TE) is one of the biggest youth-run NGOs in India. They have over 25,000 volunteers focused on motivating individuals to volunteer at least once a month and make a difference by providing quality education to financially challenged children.

KRCPL has partnered with TE to support the mentorship and skill development program for school and college students. The NGO conducted various initiatives throughout the year for the beneficiaries where KRCPL colleagues volunteered.

The Climate Thinker

The Climate Thinker is a non-government organization with the aim to prepare the current and future generations against climate change through sustainable development, circular economy and policy advocacy. The NGO promotes climate change education, citizen science program, alternative energy, carbon mitigation and building resilience against changing the climate for marginalized communities.

KRCPL has collaborated with The Climate Thinker on a project to organize an annual science fair for students from our partner NGO-run schools addressing climate change.

The project focuses on climate-related education and advocacy, enhancing the quality of the science fair. The program also promotes innovation amongst the students and fosters a deeper understanding of climate change.
