

Amendments to the general collective agreement for the private sector

The latest amendments of the general collective agreement for the private sector (GCAPS), published in the Official Gazette No. 150/2016 dated 10 August 2016, envisage that in cases of natural disasters employees are entitled to a paid leave of up to 7 days, as opposed to 3 days applicable prior to the amendments.

In addition, the amendments prescribe that in cases of emergency and crisis situations due to natural and other disasters which are declared by means of a decision of the Government of the Republic of Macedonia or another authorized body or institution, employers are allowed to grant more days off work for the period covered by the decision declaring the natural disaster.

The amendments enter into force on the day they are published in the Official Gazette, i.e. 10 August 2016.

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
