JOHOR BAHRU-SINGAPORE RAPID TRANSIT SYSTEM (RTS)

(RTS) is an international cross-border rapid transit system that will connect Johor Bahru, Malaysia and Woodlands, Singapore, crossing the Strait of Johor. It will consist of two stations, with the Malaysian terminus at Bukit Chagar station and the Singaporean terminus at Woodlands North station

Connectivity

- Connecting Johor Bahru and Singapore seamlessly with a stress-free, jam-free mode of transport.
- Integration with other modes of transport at both end stations.

Reduce Daily Congestion

- Reduces congestion on Johor-Singapore Causeway.
- Currently more than 350,000 people use the Causeway daily.

- Opportunities for local companies to venture into the supply chain for construction and operations as well as The Wadi Hana Maintenance Depot.
