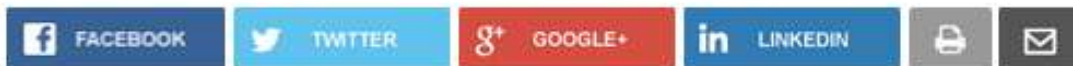

Among those who took part in this year's conference were KPMG managing partner Datuk Johan Idris, Tesco chief executive officer Datuk Georg Fischer, sports presenter Abbas Saad and Gamuda Bhd Group Human Resources and Administration director Lai Tak Ming.

"Out of the thousands of resumes received prior to the fair, only about 200 graduates and working professionals were invited to engage with top-performing corporate chief executive officers and senior management on a more intimate level.
