Corporate Tax

In Corporate Tax, we advise Swiss and international clients from all sectors on complex tax matters from both a legal and a company management perspective. We also answer specific tax questions on issues, such as salary and expense payments and succession arrangements, as well as providing tax management services including tax reporting, tax risk management and tax planning for corporate groups.

Financial Services Tax

For instance, we assist Swiss banks with preparing Swiss and foreign tax statements and answer questions on stamp duty law and withholding tax. We also analyze financial products and help banks to compile term sheets.

This involves correctly handling employer obligations in the case of cross-border employment relationships, preparing tax returns for employees in line with an employer's specific secondment policy, and designing and marketing KPMG's own software solutions for processing international secondments.

VAT
