# GTA Extends Validity Periods for Key Tax Certificates

Aimed at enhancing ease of doing business and reducing administrative burden for taxpayers, the General Tax Authority (GTA) has announced the extension of validity periods for several essential tax certificates. These changes are part of the GTA's ongoing commitment to streamline tax-related procedures, support taxpayers, and foster a more business-friendly environment in Qatar.

Key certificate updates are summarized in the table below:

NOC Type	Original Validity	New Validity
Share Transfer	30 days	180 days
Tax Compliance Certificate	30 days	1 year
Commercial Registration Cancellation	30 days	90 days
Release of tax retention	30 days	90 days
