

Foreword

Welcome to the Q3 2025 edition of Turkish Startup Investments Review with the collaboration of KPMG Turkey M&A and the 212 teams.

This is the twentieth edition of our quarterly review, aimed at highlighting key trends, opportunities, and challenges in the venture capital market, both globally and in Turkey.

Global venture capital investment rose to \$120.7 billion in Q3 2025 from \$101.1 billion in Q2 2025, marking the fourth consecutive quarter of strong global growth. The increase was supported by renewed investor optimism and liquidity, alongside heightened activity in Aldriven sectors. The total number of VC deals worldwide also grew compared to the previous quarter, reaching 7,579 in Q3 2025 vs. 7,356 in Q2 2025. In Q3 2025, the most active and investor-favored sectors included artificial intelligence, defensetech, healthtech, quantum computing, and alternative energy. One of the most encouraging developments in Q3 2025 was the rebound of IPO activity, which not only validated valuations across key sectors but also restored confidence that exit windows for VC-backed companies are reopening—signaling a healthier and more constructive market heading into 2026.

In Q3 2025, the Turkish startup ecosystem recorded a total of 121 transactions amounting to \$234.6 million, including acquisitions. Although overall deal volume declined compared to Q2 2025, the ecosystem demonstrated a notable increase in the number of transactions, rising from 46 deals in the previous quarter. The main reason for the drop in deal volume is the one-off impact of the acquisition of Trendyol Go by Uber Technologies for \$700 million in Q2 2025. A key highlight of the quarter was the \$80 million early-stage investment in local fintech player Midas, led by QED Investors.

Looking ahead to Q4 2025, global venture activity is expected to remain steady, supported by persistent momentum in Al-driven innovation and infrastructure. Artificial intelligence will continue to dominate investor focus—particularly across applications in robotics, quantum computing, and advanced hardware—while defensetech and fintech are also likely to attract sustained interest. As liquidity conditions improve and IPO markets reopen, exit activity is anticipated to strengthen further toward year-end. However, investors are expected to stay selective amid ongoing geopolitical uncertainties and evolving trade dynamics, favoring companies with scalable business models and clear paths to profitability. In Türkiye, a similar trend is anticipated as political and macroeconomic uncertainties shape investor sentiment. Consequently, capital deployment is expected to focus on resilient, sustainable ventures with proven business fundamentals rather than rapid expansion or speculative growth.

Main highlights in Türkiye's startup ecosystem in Q3 2025

Globally, VC investment rose to \$120.7 billion across 7,579 deals in Q3 2025, up from \$101.1 billion and 7,356 deals in the previous quarter. Despite persistent geopolitical tensions and shifting trade dynamics, investor confidence strengthened, supported by renewed liquidity and robust activity in AI, defensetech, and quantum computing. The largest deal of the quarter was Anthropic's \$13 billion raise, followed by xAI's \$10 billion and Mistral's \$1.5 billion rounds—highlighting continued enthusiasm for AI, so as the transformative technologies. VC investors maintained a selective stance, prioritizing scalable business models and dual-use innovations, while rising IPO activity signaled a gradual reopening of exit opportunities heading into 2026.

While global VC investment activity increased both in deal volume and deal count during Q3 2025, the Turkish startup ecosystem moved in the opposite direction, with total deal volume falling to \$234.6 million from \$857.9 million in Q2 2025, despite an increase in deal count compared to the previous quarter, mainly due to the absence of large-scale transactions.

Investment activity was seen across all stages. Early-stage investments accounted for the largest share of total deal volume at 66.3% (\$155.5 million), while startup acquisitions represented 25.6%. In terms of deal count, seed-stage investment led the quarter with 103 transactions, representing 85% of the total deal count, followed by 10 startup acquisitions. Notably, 5 of the top 10 largest deals were early-stage rounds and 3 were seed-stage rounds, collectively accounting for a significant share c.96.4% of the total deal volume excluding acquisitions.

Local investors led in terms of deal count, while foreign investors dominated in deal volume. Local investors were involved in 114 transactions, representing a deal volume of \$72.9 million which is 31.1% of the total deal volume. In contrast, foreign investors participated in 7 deals and contributed a significantly larger share of the total deal volume—68.9%.

The Artificial Intelligence vertical was the top in terms of number of deals with 19 transactions, followed by SaaS with 16 transactions, healthtech with 12. However, in terms of deal volume, the fintech vertical led significantly with \$94.9 million deal volume coming from 7 deals, followed by gaming and robotics verticals which are \$69.9 million and \$49.3 million respectively.


Midas, a leading Turkish fintech platform that enables seamless stock, investment fund and crypto trading and investments in global markets, secured an \$80 million early-stage investment in August 2025. The round was led by US-based QED Investors, with participation from IFC, HSG, Quantum Light, Spice Expeditions, Spark Capital, Portage Ventures, Bek Ventures, Nigel Morris, and George Rzepecki. With this funding, Midas aims to strengthen its technological infrastructure and broaden its investment offerings to cater to advanced investors.

In July 2025, Good Job Games, secured a \$60 million early-stage investment, co-led by Menlo Ventures and Anthos Capital, with participation from Bessemer Venture Partners. The company aims to use the funding to build a lasting entertainment brand through high-engagement, socially driven gaming experiences.

DOF Robotics, a leading developer of motion-based simulation and VR entertainment systems, went public in September 2025, selling 29% of its shares for \$49.3 million. The IPO was described as a strategic step to support DOF Robotics' sustainable growth, enhance its ability to pursue value-creating investments, and strengthen global brand recognition.

Goldtag, a fintech company leveraging blockchain technology to enable the trading of precious metals such as gold, silver, and platinum, secured a \$10 million early-stage investment in September 2025. The round was led by RePie Portföy, with participation from Turkcell, Colendi, Finberg, and Inveo Portföy. With this funding, Goldtag will launch its tokenization infrastructure, aiming to expand access to alternative assets in a scalable and regulation-compliant manner.

Yuppion, a Turkey-based e-commerce startup specializing in stockless operations, has sold 80% of its shares to US-based Al-powered software company Prinella for \$10 million. Yuppion describes this transaction not merely as an exit, but as the emergence of a strong new player in the global market. Following the acquisition, the company is expanding its operations by adding Los Angeles-based production to its existing activities.





Breakdown of startup deals by sub-sector



Leading Verticals and Prominent Deals

- In Q3 2025, Artificial Intelligence was the leading vertical in terms of deal count, with 19 transactions. It was followed by SaaS and healthtech, with 16 and 12 transactions respectively, while IoT and biotech recorded 11 transactions each.
- Virgosol, an AI powered full stack testing platform, secured \$3.5 million funding from Revo Capital (Fund III).

- Menulux, a SaaS startup that automates the restaurants' processes, secured a \$540 thousand investment from ATP GSYO.
- Healthtech startup
 Diştedavim attracted \$440
 thousand investment from
 Casta Healthcare.

Deal volume (USD million)




Startup deals according to their investment stage

Number of deals by Investment Stage




Deal volume by Investment Stage (USD million)



- Seed-stage investments recorded the highest number of deals with 103 transactions, while early-stage investments led in deal volume with a total of \$156 million.
- There were a total of 10 startup acquisitions with a combined deal volume of \$60 million, however the deal value was not announced for 6 of these deals. The volume is mainly driven by IPO of DOF Robotics, and share sales of Yuppion, Raquun IoT and Menulux.
- Early-stage investments were recorded in 7 transactions, accounting for 66% (\$156 million) of the total deal volume. The largest deal by far was the early-stage investment of Midas for \$80 million.
- In Q3 2025, only one late-stage investments was observed a biotech startup Algrotech, received a \$22.2 thousand investment.

Breakdown of startup deals by quarters



- The total investment volume of \$174.6 million in the third quarter of 2025 showed an increase, up from \$153 million in the second quarter of 2025, and also represented a notable rise compared to the same period of the previous year, when Q3 2024 recorded \$52.9 million.
- The number of deals increased to 111 in Q3 2025, from 39 in Q2 2025.
- For comparison purposes, only seed-stage, early-stage and late-stage deals are exhibited in the above graph, excluding startup acquisitions.

- Founded in 2019 by Bahadır Özdemir, Airalo is a telecommunications startup providing eSIM packages across more than 200 countries and regions, enabling users to instantly connect to mobile networks worldwide. In July 2025, the company raised \$220 million ian a late-stage funding round led by CVC, with participation from Peak XV and Antler, in exchange for a 22% equity stake. The proceeds will be used to enhance customer experience and strengthen Airalo's global service offering.
- Founded in 2021 by Burkay Gür and Görkem Yurtseven, fal is a developer-focused generative media platform based in the US. In July 2025, the company raised \$125 million in a late-stage funding round led by Meritech Capital Partners, with participation from Salesforce Ventures, Shopify Ventures, Google Al Futures Fund, Bessemer Venture Partners, Kindred Ventures, Andreessen Horowitz, Notable Capital, First Round Capital, Unusual Ventures, and Village Global.
- Aalo Atomics, a US-based advanced nuclear technology startup, raised \$100 million in an early-stage funding round in August 2025. The round was led by Valor Equity
 Partners, with participation from ITK Ventures, Eksim Ventures, Kindred Ventures, Fifty Years, Alumni Ventures, VamosVentures, Tishman Speyer, Perpetual Ventures,
 Nucleation Capital, NRG Energy, MCJ, Hitachi Ventures, Harpoon, Gaingels, Fine Structure Venture, Crosscut Ventures, Crescent Enterprises, and Startupfon Fund Coop.

- Delve, a US-based AI company, raised \$32 million in a Series A round led by Insight Partners in July 2025 in exchange for roughly 11% equity. The startup offers an AI-powered compliance and security automation platform that helps companies rapidly meet frameworks like SOC 2, HIPAA, ISO 27001 and GDPR.
- Born, a Germany-based AI company, raised \$15 million in an early-stage funding round in September 2025, led by Tencent, Laton Ventures, and Accel. Born develops AI-powered social companion characters, such as the virtual pet app "Pengu" which aims to create shared experiences among friends and has already attracted over 15 million users.
- Palabra.ai, a UK-based Artificial Intelligence startup, raised \$8.4 million in a seed-stage funding round in August 2025. The round was led by 776, with participation from Hüsnü Akın Babayiğit, Max Mullen, Anne Lee Skates, Mehdi Ghissassi, and Namat Bahram among other private investors.

- PeriVision, a Switzerland-based healthtech company, raised \$3 million in a seed-stage funding round in September 2025. The round was backed by Arya VC, DART Ventures, Zühlke Ventures, MEDKAP, SICTIC, Yapay Zeka Fabrikası, Venturekick, InaTec, Juchum Foundation, CADFEM, and OMNIUM.
- TASS Vision, an Uzbekistan-based AL company, secured \$1.5 million in a seed-stage investment round in July 2025. The funding was led by DOMINO Ventures and Purple Ventures, with participation from Pragma Tech VC, Sabah Fund, Caucasus VC, Big Sky Capital, IT Park Ventures, 500 Global, UzVC, Activat, and private investors including Bachrom Abduqadirov and Ahror Abdukarimov.
- Breathment, a Germany-based healthtech startup, raised \$932 thousand in a seed-stage funding round in August 2025. The round included investments from Meerkat, SCE Freiraum Ventures, Ipp Investment, and private investors such as Michael Friebe, Claudia Fell, and Alihan Özbayrak.

- US-based AI company Loops AI, which develops corporate AI agents to enhance the relationship between brands and their customers making interactions more personal, faster, and more efficient received an investment of \$125 thousand from the Silicon Valley–based Launch Accelerator Fund in July 2025. Its acceptance into the Launch Accelerator program indicates that the company's vision has gained recognition and validation on a global scale. In September 2025, Loops AI secured an additional \$400 thousand investment from Mantra, Monday Capital, and an undisclosed investor.
- Myth AI, which develops generative AI-based solutions for the textile and apparel industry, raised \$305 thousand in a seed-stage funding round from Revo Capital and Inveo Ventures. With this investment, the company plans to further advance its technology and expand its presence, particularly in the South Asian market.

- Eachlabs, founded by Eftal Yurtseven, Ferhat Budak and Canberk Sinangil in 2024, received an investment from Revo Capital in an undisclosed amount in September 2025. Eachlab's mission is to make artificial intelligence accessible to every developer and every company in the world. Revo Capital's new investment stands out as a strategic move aimed at accelerating the company's expansion into the enterprise market.
- Flowla, UK-based SaaS company, received an undisclosed amount of investment from Revo Capital. The company streamlines sales and onboarding by unifying all workflows into a single digital workspace integrated with popular tools like Google and Youtube.
- 1Komma5 received an investment from Sabancı Climate Ventures for an undisclosed amount in July 2025. Commenting on the investment, 1Komma5 stated that the new funding will be used to accelerate the company's organic growth and scale its energy management software and virtual power plant, Heartbeat AI. The company's core mission is to enable homeowners in Europe and Australia to transition from fossil fuels to cleaner and more affordable electricity.


