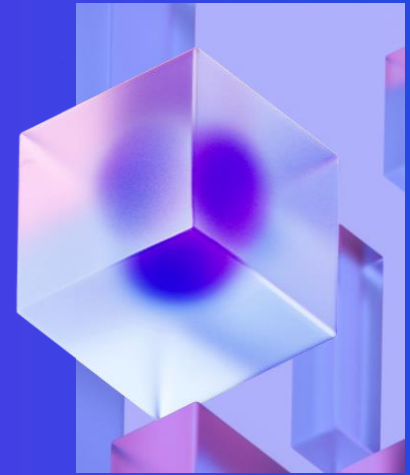


Understanding and Managing System Performance
