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Legislative update: Ways and Means releases "Green Book"

The Green Book's official title is: *Background Material and Data on the Programs within the Jurisdiction of the Committee on Ways and Means,* and it is available electronically on the Ways and Means <u>website</u>.

The Green Book was prepared by the Congressional Research Service (CRS) under the direction of the Ways and Means staff.

The Ways and Means Green Book is not to be confused with the Treasury Department's explanation of tax proposals in the administration's budget—i.e., Treasury's "Green Book"—or with the Joint Committee on Taxation's explanations of tax legislation enacted during a particular Congress, which is referred to as the "Blue Book."

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
