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## **Treasury position nominees announced**

The White House has announced the individuals President Trump intends to nominate for certain U.S. Treasury Department positions. The release does not address any nominations with respect to Treasury's Office of Tax Policy.

The nominations announced in the press release are:

- James Donovan—Deputy Secretary of the Treasury. Mr. Donovan is an Adjunct Professor at the University of Virginia School of Law and a Managing Director at Goldman Sachs.
- Adam Lerrick—Deputy Under Secretary of the Treasury for International Finance and (after confirmation) Assistant Secretary of the Treasury for International Finance. Mr. Lerrick is a Visiting Scholar at the American Enterprise Institute.
- Andrew K. "Drew" Maloney—Deputy Under Secretary of the Treasury for Legislative Affairs and (after confirmation) Assistant Secretary of the Treasury Legislative Affairs. Mr. Maloney was Vice President of Global Government and External Affairs for the Hess Corporation and was CEO of Ogilvy Government Relations.
- David Malpass—Under Secretary of the Treasury for International Affairs. Mr. Malpass previously was Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Treasury for Developing Nations in the Reagan Administration, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State in the George H. W. Bush Administration, Senior Tax Analyst on the Senate Budget Committee during the preparations for the 1986 Tax Act, and Republican Staff Director of Congress's Joint Economic Committee.
- Sigal Mandelker—Under Secretary of the Treasury for Terrorism and Financial Intelligence. Ms. Mandelker is currently a partner at a law firm.

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• Brent James McIntosh—General Counsel. Mr. McIntosh is a partner in a law firm.

Dates have not yet been set for Senate confirmation hearings.

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
