## Proposed regulations: 298 regulations to be withdrawn, 79 modified

The U.S. Treasury Department and IRS today released for publication in the Federal Register a notice of proposed rulemaking (REG-132197-17) that would:

- Remove 298 regulations that are found to be no longer necessary because they do not have any current or future applicability under the Code
- Amend 79 regulations to reflect the proposed removal of these 298 regulations

The <u>proposed regulations</u> [PDF 412 KB] are being issued in response to executive orders to reduce regulatory burden for taxpayers by revoking or revising existing tax regulations that meet certain criteria.

As noted in a related Treasury Department <u>release</u>, the regulations proposed to be removed can be categorized as:

- Regulations interpreting provisions of the Code that have been repealed
- Regulations interpreting provisions that have been significantly revised and the existing regulations do not account for these revisions
- Regulations that are no longer applicable

Comments and requests for a public hearing on these proposed regulations must be received by May 14, 2018.

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
