CMS released several 2019 proposed payment rules with payment increases: <u>skilled nursing facility (SNF)</u> 1.9%; <u>hospices</u> 1.8%; <u>inpatient rehabilitation facilities</u> 0.9%; and <u>inpatient</u> <u>psychiatric facilities</u> 0.98% ; in addition, SNF payments would move to a new <u>"patient-driven model" based</u> on patients' conditions and needs, rather than volume and intensity of service.

HRSA <u>withdrew a proposed rule</u> modifying 340B program ceiling prices and penalties...<u>OMB is reviewing</u> a proposed rule to help transition ACOs to "performance-based risk;" at the same time,

71% of the original MSSP ACO participants may leave the program if required to assume downside financial risk... The <u>FDA</u> and <u>FTC sent 13 warning letters</u> to e-cigarette manufacturers and distributors whose packaging resembles children-friendly products... FDA <u>delayed by 18 months</u> the compliance deadline for food manufacturers to update nutrition labels.

Healthcare law and policy news

According to HHS Secretary <u>Alex Azar</u>, President Trump's drug pricing speech, now scheduled for May 8th, will go "much further" than proposals in the President's Budget; while FDA Commissioner <u>Gottlieb announced</u> HHS may reconsider safe harbor protection for prescription drug rebates under the antikickback statute.

The NIH announced <u>details of a precision medicine initiative to</u> collect and study health data of at least 1 million Americans... CMS <u>reported</u> that it previously overestimated savings from the Independence at Home Demonstration in year two by 26%.... CMS released the <u>2018 Quality Measure Development Plan</u> describing progress in developing quality measures to support the QPP... ONC and SAMHSA released fact sheets on the "Disclosure of Substance Use Disorder Patient Records" for <u>providers</u> and <u>health information exchanges</u>.

HHS <u>petitioned the Supreme Court</u> to review a <u>case brought by</u> <u>Allina Health</u> over how DSH payments are calculated...Advocates <u>sued the Maine Department of Health and Human Services</u> to force implementation of a voter-approved law expanding the Medicaid program, which has been stalled by the Governor... A <u>Commonwealth Fund survey</u> found that the uninsured rate has increased to 15.5%, up from a low of 12.7% in 2016.

Fitbit <u>announced a partnership</u> with Google to improve the integration of patient-generated and clinical data across the healthcare system... an <u>Annals of Internal Medicine study</u> found hospital readmissions within 7 days after discharge are more preventable than later readmissions.
