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Healthcare regulatory news

The Trump Administration <u>unveiled a plan</u> to reorganize the federal government, including consolidating public welfare programs into HHS and renaming it the Department of Health and Public Welfare... <u>Department of Labor finalized a rule</u> to allow businesses and trade groups to form association health plans, which are exempt from certain ACA plan requirements; Attorneys General from New York and Massachusetts will <u>sue to stop</u> the rule.

SAMHSA <u>announced \$390 million</u> in state opioid response grants... FDA <u>plans to waive certain fees</u> for drug manufacturers to spur innovative HIV drugs... HHS further <u>delayed implementation of the Common Rule</u> on human subjects research until January 21, 2019... CMS is <u>seeking comment</u> on the impact and burden of the physician self-referral (Stark) law, and potential changes to support coordinated care.



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Healthcare law and policy news

Senate Finance Committee will hold a hearing with HHS Secretary Alex Azar on June 26 to discuss prescription drug affordability and HHS' Drug Pricing Blueprint... A New York Times Editorial urged use of a little used federal law to lower drug prices for certain public health needs... HRSA told the Senate HELP Committee that it needs more authority to track and monitor provider 340B savings.

Senate Budget Committee Republicans <u>asked Secretary Azar for</u> <u>details on</u> what HHS is doing to address improper Medicare and Medicaid payments, which totaled \$89 billion in FY17... <u>MedPAC</u> and <u>MACPAC</u> issued their respective Reports to Congress... HHS <u>OIG plans to review</u> whether MA plans are inappropriately denying access to, or reimbursement for, services to increase profits.

Maine's Governor <u>appealed a judge's order</u> to expand the state's Medicaid program, while the <u>state legislature voted</u> to fund the expansion... Avalere <u>reports that ACA premium</u> filings for 2019 are 15% higher on average than 2018 rates... <u>Centene, Molina</u>, and <u>Oscar</u> plan to enter into new, or expand in existing, state ACA marketplaces next year.

AMA testified at a California Department of Insurance hearing, urging regulators to block the proposed CVS-Aetna merger ... CVS reached an agreement with the US Postal Service to deliver prescriptions to patients in one or two days for a \$4.99 fee... Atul Gawande was appointed CEO of the Boston-based Amazon, Berkshire Hathaway and JPMorgan Chase healthcare venture.
