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# Healthcare regulatory news

FDA issued draft guidance to boost transparency of regulatory decisions on medical devices and announced initiatives to speed decisions on low-risk devices and accelerate patient access... FDA also released draft guidance on labeling dietary supplements containing microbes.

<u>Lewin Group</u> found that CJR reduced average Medicare episode payments by 3.3% in the program's first year... Meanwhile, studies in *JAMA* found that <u>mandatory CJR participation</u> reduced postacute care after lower extremity joint replacements and that <u>BPCI hospital participants</u> did not significantly increase surgical volume

or change their case mix in response to program incentives... In a speech about HHS' <u>value-based care priorities</u>, Secretary Alex Azar signaled openness to more mandatory models.



## Healthcare law and policy news

House leaders <u>urged MedPAC to explore</u> implications of hospital consolidation on Medicare costs and whether 340B drug discount incentives prompt use of more expensive products... A <u>Health Affairs study</u> found that California hospital-employed physicians increased from 25% in 2010 to 40% in 2016, associated with a 12% increase in ACA premiums and price increases for specialist (9%) and primary-care (5%) services... <u>OIG found</u> that one-third of residents experienced harm from care provided in SNFs and more than half of the harm (adverse events) was preventable.

Two <u>preliminary analyses</u> of insurer filings concluded that average ACA premiums will increase less than 4% in 2019... A <u>federal court of appeals ruled</u> that HHS erred in withholding \$5 million in cost-sharing reduction payments from Montana Health Co-Op... Plaintiffs in the 20-state lawsuit challenging the ACA's constitutionality urged a district court to strike down the entire law; while <u>DOJ asked that any legal remedy</u> be delayed a year to prevent market "chaos."

Maine Governor Paul LePage filed a Medicaid expansion plan, but urged CMS to reject it... 4,574 Arkansas residents lost Medicaid coverage for failing to satisfy work requirements.

Seven large health systems launched <u>Civica Rx</u> to <u>manufacture</u> <u>generic drugs</u>.... Hospital groups <u>filed another lawsuit</u> to reverse CMS' cut to Part B reimbursement for 340B drugs... <u>PhRMA-sponsored analysis</u> concluded that hospitals charge nearly 500% of their costs for drugs... Novartis <u>will sell</u> parts of Sandoz, its generic-drug business... WellCare Health Plans <u>completed its \$2.5 billion acquisition</u> of MeridianRx and Meridian Health Plans in two states.
