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Healthcare regulatory news

CMS [updated the Medicare local coverage determination \(LCD\) process](#) to improve beneficiaries' [access to therapies and devices](#)... A [CMS proposed rule](#) streamlines the appeal process for coverage determinations under Medicare Parts A, B, and D... CMS announced [a multi-year e-Medicare initiative](#) to improve the user experience for Medicare beneficiaries...CMS plans to [increase oversight and transparency](#) of Medicare's Accrediting Organizations.

FDA [announced program pilots](#) to evaluate [proposed changes](#) to the Special 510(k) Program to expedite medical device design and labeling changes... FDA draft guidance on [adaptive trials](#) and [master protocols](#) aim to [lower the cost of drug development](#) and spur competition... FDA [guidance cracks down on citizen petitions](#) including alerting the FTC if it suspects a brand manufacturer petition is being used to delay generic competitors... FDA [announced new steps](#) to strengthen the agency's medical device cybersecurity program.

OIG [estimated that Medicare made \\$5.7 billion](#) in unnecessary payments to inpatient rehabilitation facilities in 2013.



Healthcare law and policy news

Congress [passed opioid legislation](#), which resident Trump is expected to sign.

GAO [reported that rural hospital closures](#) from 2013 to 2017 more than doubled (64) over the previous five-year period (31)... Baylor Scott & White and Memorial Hermann [signed a letter of intent to merge](#) and create the largest health system in Texas (68 hospitals)... [Pitchbook](#) found that investment in healthcare startups is 70% greater than a year ago, driven by larger deals... [DaVita Medical Holdings agreed to pay \\$270 million](#) for False Claims Act liabilities from improper MA billing practices.

California [enacted a bill requiring PBMs](#) to register and disclose conflicts of interest, rebates, and other incentives to purchasers; meanwhile, PhRMA [refiled a lawsuit challenging \(subscription required\)](#) California's drug price transparency law requiring manufacturers to provide advance notice of price increases.

[Kaiser Family Foundation reported](#) that average premiums for employer-sponsored family health coverage rose 5% this year to \$19,616; individual coverage increased 3% to \$6,896... A [Health Affairs analysis found](#) that 60% of the population lives in a county with at least three ACA insurers, down from 93% in 2016... Pew [reported that one of out of five patients](#) may not be accurately matched to their individual electronic health record at facilities they have previously visited.
