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# Healthcare regulatory news

HHS <u>requested comments</u> on modifying HIPAA privacy rules to better promote coordinated care... OMB is reviewing <u>advance</u> <u>notices</u> for CY2020 Medicare Advantage and Part D program changes.

FDA <u>guidance</u> would <u>reclassify insulin</u>, growth hormones, and <u>other living cell substances</u> as biological products to encourage generic competition... an FDA <u>proposed rule</u> amends the definition of "biological product" and <u>revised guidance</u> addresses biosimilar development questions.

FDA withdrew a generic drug labeling proposed rule and announced changes to generic cancer drug labels... FDA guidance documents aim to relax current good marketing practice (CGMP) requirements for drug compounding facilities and clarify the role of data integrity in CGMP... FDA will increase pharmaceutical enforcement actions and improve inspection assessments, including through a new inspection protocol for sterile generic drugs.

OIG <u>released its semiannual</u> report to Congress and <u>reported that</u> <u>Medicare improperly paid</u> \$34 million from 2015 through 2017 for inpatient durable medical equipment, prosthetics, orthotics, and other supplies.





## Healthcare law and policy news

ACA open enrollment ends tomorrow; as of December 8<sup>th</sup>, <u>4.1</u> million individuals had enrolled, 11.7% behind last year's pace; CMS extended enrollment for call-center customers who called before December 15.

The Supreme Court <u>will hear oral arguments</u> on whether state-law failure-to-warn claims are preempted by FDA action... A <u>federal appeals court ruled</u> that Blue Cross Blue Shield companies must defend against antitrust class action claims... Washington Post <u>reported that 16 generic manufacturers</u> and over 300 drugs are implicated in a lawsuit alleging "cartel"-like behavior, including price fixing.

California and New York <u>approved the Cigna-Express Scripts</u> <u>merger</u> with conditions... Walmart and Express Scripts <u>extended</u> their network agreement <u>by three years</u>... Walgreens and FedEx <u>will launch</u> next-day prescription deliveries... Kaleo will <u>introduce</u> a generic version of naloxone.

The House passed <u>the IMPROVE Act</u>, which would <u>crack down</u> on pharmaceutical manufacturers knowingly misclassifying branded products as generics in Medicaid; the Senate anticipates passing its own version.

An NPR-IBM poll found that 34% of individuals under 35 years old delayed care due to costs, compared to 19% of those between 35 and 64, and 8% of those above 65... Healthcare <a href="hiring">hiring</a> (32,000) exceeded all other sector hiring in November; TheKnowledgeAcademy.com <a href="projects">projects</a> more than 1.1 million new healthcare jobs by 2026.
