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Healthcare regulatory news

CMS released the 2020 MA and Part D Advance Notice Part II and Draft Call Letter, which would increase MA rates by 1.59%... A long awaited HHS OIG proposed rule would amend a safe harbor to exclude protection of Medicare and Medicaid rebates between drug manufacturers and Plans/PBMs, while protecting discounts offered to patient at the point-of-sale. HHS is <u>drafting proposed regulations</u> to reform Stark Law and the Anti-Kickback Statute... <u>VA released proposed access standards to</u> <u>determine when</u> Eligible Veterans would be able to choose between eligible community providers and care at a VA facility.

FDA Commissioner Scott Gottlieb announced efforts to advance real world evidence, including a stakeholder-developed framework on enhancing clinical trials through digital systems...FDA final guidance clarifies labeling requirements for products approved through the accelerated pathway... FDA officials believe it could take nearly a year to catch up on work delayed by the government shutdown, particularly reviewing new drug applications.

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Healthcare law and policy news

<u>CBO estimated that the government shutdown cost the economy</u> <u>a net \$3 billion in permanent losses; also, CBO projects that</u> <u>Medicare spending will increase 7% annually between 2020 and</u> <u>2029 when it reaches \$1.3 trillion.</u>

CMS launched a "<u>What's Covered" app</u> to help traditional Medicare beneficiaries determine what items and services are covered... CMS Administrator Seema Verma <u>discussed quality and</u> <u>coming demonstrations</u> on rural telehealth and state-based payment arrangements at the CMS Quality Conference... the White House released its <u>National Drug Control Strategy</u>.

The <u>Senate Finance</u> and <u>House Oversight</u> Committees explored approaches for reducing prescription drug prices... Meanwhile, IQVIA <u>forecasted that prescription drug prices</u> will grow between 0 and 3% over the next five years, while manufacturers' sales grow of 3 to 6%... PhRMA is considering a <u>self-imposed cap</u> on drug price increases.

Anthem will <u>launch its own PBM</u>, IngenioRx, in Q2 2019... AstraZeneca <u>entered an outcome-based contract</u> for its blood thinner with UPMC... Aetna <u>will partner with Apple</u> to develop a new health app for Apple Watches to drive wellness... HCA <u>finalized its purchase</u> of Mission Health. AHRQ <u>reported that hospital-acquired conditions</u> declined 13% from 2014 to 2017... A <u>NEJM study</u> found that e-cigarettes were twice as effective as traditional nicotine replacement methods for smoking cessation.

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
