Legislative update: House Rules Committee releases new legislative text for "Build Back Better Act"

The Rules Committee of the U.S. House of Representatives today released new text of legislative language for the "Build Back Better Act."

The new [legislative text](#) [PDF 3.46 MB] (1684 pages) includes tax provisions that generally begin on:

- Page 1085 (under Subtitle D, "Green Energy")
- Page 1440 (under Subtitle F, the "Social Safety Net")
- Page 1509 (under Subtitle G, "Responsibly Funding Our Priorities")

This legislative language is still subject to change, and it is unknown if it will be approved by the House.
