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Final rule: Responsibility for administering alcohol taxes moved from CBP to Treasury

The U.S. Treasury Department and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) on March 6, 2024, published in the Federal Register a <u>final rule</u> [PDF 224 KB] that moves responsibility for administering refunds, reduced tax rates, and tax credits on imported alcohol from CBP to Treasury on January 1, 2023.

The final rule adopts, with no changes, <u>interim amendments</u> [PDF 235 KB] to the CBP regulations that were published in the Federal Register on December 30, 2022 (CBP Decision 22–26).

The rule is effective March 6, 2024.

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
