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Campaign 2016: Tax proposals of Democratic, Republican presidential candidates (update)

A slide presentation prepared by KPMG sets forth the key tax proposals of the presidential candidates of the two major political parties—Secretary Clinton and Mr. Trump—as of October 18, 2016.
