RIRS Disengages Revenue Collection Agents

The Rivers State Internal Revenue Service (RIRS) has disengaged all its Revenue Agents (RAs) to address issues of multiple taxation and harassment of taxpayers in the State. The RIRS has ordered the affected RAs to desist from acting in its name, whilst taxpayers have been advised to stop dealing with them and continue to pay their taxes directly to the RIRS.

This is a welcome development for improvement in tax administration in the State. Hopefully, it will be sustained by the new Executive Chairman of RIRS, Mr. Thank-God Adoage Norteh, as he pursues his objective of improving revenue generation in the State whilst creating a tax-friendly business environment and ensuring professionalism of the RIRS.
