Notice is hereby given to members and creditors pursuant to section 1603 (previously section 508(4)) of the Act that:

- The Liquidator has elected not to convene an annual meeting of members and creditors.
- The Liquidator has prepared and lodged with ASIC a report that complies with section 1603 (previously section 508(3)) of the Act. A copy of this report is available to creditors free of charge, upon written request to the Liquidator. It includes the Liquidator’s summary of receipts & payments, details of remuneration incurred, and outstanding matters to finalise the liquidation.
