A. TDS/TCS: Managed Compliance Services for TDS Deductors or TCS Collectors


Under the Income-tax Act 1961, almost all payments are subject to either deduction of tax (TDS) or collection of tax (TCS). Various returns and compliance obligations are also attached to the TDS/TCS. If there is any default in such compliances, there is penalty and interest liability. Therefore, it is important to conduct correct and timely compliance of TDS/TCS. B. Obtaining credit for TDS/TCS – Form 26AS reconciliation services for taxpayers

Post TDS/TCS by deductor or collector, the other party is eligible for credit of the said TDS/TCS. The details of TDS/TCS done by the deductor or collector are available to the other party financial year wise, on the Income Tax department website in Form 26AS. It is imperative that these details reconcile with amounts recorded in the financial statements. This information is critical at the time of preparing the income-tax return and tax assessment. In case of voluminous transactions, there are several challenges in claiming correct TDS/TCS credit and their reconciliation with the financial statements as well as books of accounts of the taxpayer. Therefore, it is worthwhile to consider outsourcing this as part of managed services to KPMG in India.
