

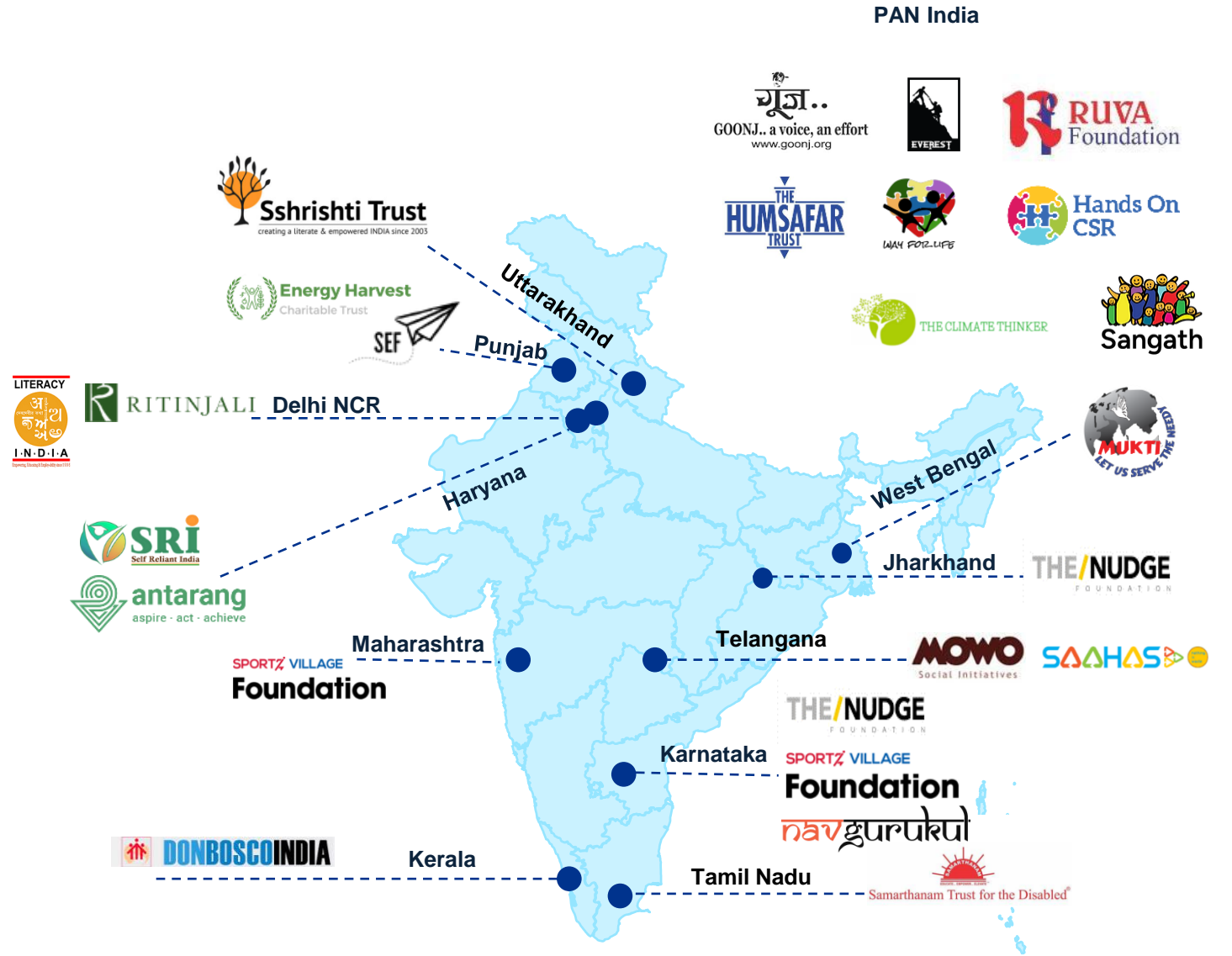

Location: Bengaluru and Jharkhand

The/Nudge Institute is dedicated to uplifting marginalized communities by providing skill development and livelihood opportunities.

(a) Supporting Project Management Units (PMU)

KGSPL is supporting the Project Management Unit (PMU) with the objective to realize the National Rural Livelihood Mission's (NRLM) — a Government of India's flagship program to eradicate rural poverty, by helping develop a national strategy, design and guideline through the graduation approach adapted to and built on top of community institutions.

(b) Capacity building of non-profit organizations

We are also supporting the capacity building of non-profit organizations from The/Nudge Incubator and Accelerator cohorts to undertake charitable activities toward poverty alleviation.

Location: Bengaluru

NavGurukul offers a transformative residential course designed for young women from underserved and diverse communities. The program is purpose-built to enhance the employability of marginalized individuals, giving them access to aspirational careers such as Software Engineering, Business, Finance, Education and Graphic Design. The commitment extends to offering higher education that directly connects to employability, ensuring marginalized youth not only gain quality education but also access to impactful careers.

KGSPL has partnered with NavGurukul to provide Residential Software Programming course, a project spread over two years to set up the Bengaluru campus that will house girl students from different parts of India. This will help the youth, especially women, gain access to aspirational careers that would have otherwise been difficult to achieve.

Location: Delhi

Ritinjali is one of our partner NGOs based in Delhi. It is committed to ensuring that all children, irrespective of gender and social strata, have access to education.

KGSPL supports batches of current students and few alums at Ritinjali's Second Chance School (SCS). SCS is a two-year residential and day school program for disadvantaged boys between 18–24 years of age who did not get a first chance at education. The students are enrolled from across the country. The program includes educational skills, vocational skills, development of life skills, social values, communication skills, spoken English, technology and multimedia literacy.

This program focuses on developing life skills through classroom training, technical education, entrepreneurship training, mentorship, internship and job placements.

Literacy India



Location: Gurugram

Literacy India (LI) is one of our partner NGOs operating from Gurugram. LI focuses on educating underprivileged women and children and empowering them to become self-reliant and employable.

KGSPIL supports the Literacy India Community College (LICC) which aims to provide accessible higher education, skill development, and certification aligned with national standards. By creating local job opportunities and empowering women and disadvantaged groups, LICC will curb migration and foster community growth. We will be supporting 300 youth through this program.

Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled



Location: Coimbatore

The Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled is one of our NGO partners who are working extensively toward empowering persons with disabilities gain access to quality education and sustainable employment.

KGSPIL will support the cost of setting up their first residential skilling center for youth with disabilities coming from marginalized sections of the society in Coimbatore. They will provide livelihood skilling, personality development, language skills, career guidance, skilling support, and most importantly placement support etc.

The Humsafar Trust



Location: Pan India

The Humsafar Trust (HST) actively works on the health and well-being of the LGBTQ+ community.

HST strives to address the challenges faced by transgender individuals in accessing quality education, healthcare, sustainable livelihoods and socio-economic empowerment.

KGSPIL supports HST's comprehensive Transgender Entrepreneurship Programs, which aims to empower and support transgender individuals from underprivileged backgrounds in establishing and growing their own businesses. By creating an inclusive and enabling environment, this program seeks to overcome the barriers that transgender entrepreneurs face and promote their economic self-sufficiency and social integration.

MOWO Social Initiatives Foundation



Location: Hyderabad

MOWO is dedicated to promoting mobility and road safety education for women. They aim to empower women by providing them with the skills and confidence to drive safely. Their vision is to create a society where women can move freely and safely, contributing to their overall empowerment and independence.

KG SPL supports MOWO's mission is to make women independent and self-reliant through mobility and employment, aiming to create a generation of confident, empowered women. Together, we are tackling grassroots issues by training women from lower-income groups in electric auto driving.



Location: Uttarakhand

Sshrishti is our partner NGO in Uttarakhand. KGSPL actively supports Sshrishti's Community Resource Network (CRN) learning centers in Uttarakhand where they provide online education to school students and young adults in remote villages.

The centers provide support to students who are enrolled for computer classes and for remedial classes for spoken English, mathematics, etc. We endeavor to help improve academic, linguistic and digital proficiency of the students at the different centers. The focus is to help increase the knowledge levels of basic subjects to provide a strong foundation for advanced learning and practical application.

Location: Haryana

Antarang is committed to ensuring that every young person, regardless of their background, has access to career awareness, guidance, and employability skills that lead to aspirational and sustainable careers. By integrating career education into school systems and local communities, Antarang enables students to make informed career choices, equipping them with the mindsets, skills, and industry exposure needed to thrive in high-growth sectors.

With the support of KGSPL, Antarang is expanding its impact in underserved communities by empowering students in grades 9–12 to successfully transition into higher education, technical training, entrepreneurship, or meaningful employment. Through structured interventions, students gain self-awareness, career clarity, and mentorship, ensuring they move beyond low-wage work into fulfilling, future-ready careers.

Location: Bengaluru and Mumbai

Sportz Village Foundation (SVF), a sports education organization, that believes playing sports is an integral part of a child's education. This aligns perfectly with our belief that a child's holistic development is not complete without the inclusion of physical activity. We have already been working toward improving the quality of education, nutrition, skill development, honing the entrepreneurial mindset in students and integrating SVF's pioneering scientifically researched and highly tested Sport for Change program is an excellent way to ensure well-rounded development and empowerment of children from underserved communities.

We are running this program in six government schools in Bengaluru and five government schools in Mumbai. We are also running an after-school academy for few exceptionally talented children and offer them the opportunity to participate in district/state-level tournaments.



Don Bosco Welfare Centre Society



Location: Kochi

Don Bosco is a Kochi-based NGO that reaches out to and rescues children and at-risk youth with an objective to protect, educate rehabilitate and inspire them towards realizing their full potential.

KG SPL supports scholarships for higher education pursued by disadvantaged youth to secure a future in gaining meaningful employment.

Self Reliant Foundation



Location: Haryana

Self-Reliant India (SRI) works with a mission to make historically under-resourced communities self-reliant with access to quality education in India. The NGO empowers children and young adults through education and vocational training. They focus on promoting self-reliance and entrepreneurship, working toward creating a society where women have the skills and opportunities to lead independent and empowered lives.

KG SPL is supporting SRI's flagship program Nanhe Kalam which was initiated with the goal to increase the number of students from historically under-resourced schools that get admitted in the residential model schools like Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV). In this program, SRI work with local youth & Govt teachers and equip them with the latest teaching pedagogy and technology skills and these youth prepare government school students for the JNV Selection Test.

Simple Education Foundation



Location: Punjab

The Simple Education Foundation is one of our NGO partners who collaborates with government bodies to design training programs for teachers and principals, making public school education in India more engaging.

KG SPL is supporting the In-service Teacher Development Program Punjab, which is a collaborative initiative by Simple Education Foundation (SEF) and SCERT Punjab aimed at significantly enhancing teacher education and capacity-building efforts in Punjab. The program seeks to continue the momentum from previous successes, focusing on deepening the impact of teacher development to improve classroom outcomes across the state.

The Climate Thinker



Location: Pan India

The Climate Thinker aims to prepare the current and future generations against climate change through sustainable development, circular economy and policy advocacy. The NGO promotes climate change education, citizen science program, alternative energy, carbon mitigation and building resilience against changing the climate for marginalized communities.

KGSPL has collaborated with The Climate Thinker on a project to organize an annual science fair for students from our partner NGO-run schools addressing climate change.

The project focuses on climate-related education and advocacy, enhancing the quality of the science fair. The program also promotes innovation amongst the students and fosters a deeper understanding of climate change.

Mukti Green Defense System



Location: West Bengal

Mukti Green Defense System (MGDS) is one of our NGO partners focused on ensuring that workers and communities are not left behind as the world transitions toward a cleaner and more resilient future. MGDS is working in the deltaic region of the Sundarbans and other parts of West Bengal for over a decade.

KGSPL is supporting the NGO's efforts toward conserving mangroves in the deltaic region to build a climate resilient community. The initiative aims to protect the Sundarbans from river embankment erosion while promoting sustainable practices and enhancing local ecosystems.

Through the program's multi-tiered approach, we aim to facilitate long-lasting environmental benefits, create sustainable economic opportunities and drive social empowerment for the local communities.

Energy Harvest



Location: Punjab

Energy Harvest is dedicated to support research, education, training and solutions deployment to improve the environment and help the farming community through novel approaches for utilizing agricultural waste for useful purposes like soil conditioners. Their vision is to reduce biomass burning and help increase farmers income.

The proposed pilot project is supported by KGSPL and involves setting up a small-scale biochar production facility for producing biochar from paddy straw and distributing it to farmers. It is aimed at enriching soil quality, reducing agricultural waste, promoting sustainable farming practices and overall GHG reduction in the environment.

Saahas



Location: Hyderabad

Saahas is committed to providing holistic and scientific solutions to responsibly manage solid waste.

The objective of the project is to showcase biogas generation as an effective decentralized solution for biodegradable waste. We aim to set up a plant of 2 tons-per day (TPD) capacity at a host site which has a kitchen/canteen for the community.

KGSPL, along with the implementing organization, has partnered with Osmania University, Hyderabad, which is a 107-year-old institution with ~12,000 students and scholars and ~4,000 staff members, generating a large amount of waste for this biogas plant.

The project also aims to work with schools to spread awareness on environment and circular economy that will influence children and the next generation.

Location: West Bengal

Climate Thinker is one of our partner NGOs dedicated to environmental education and climate change adaptation. They focus on promoting sustainable farming practices and empowering local farmers with eco-friendly techniques. Their vision is to create a resilient future where communities are well-equipped to combat climate change and sustain their livelihoods.

KG SPL supports the proposed project that involves setting up microbiological laboratories in West Bengal to produce biofertilizers and biopesticides. This initiative aims to enrich soil quality, reduce agricultural waste, and enhance climate resilience among farmers. By supporting this project, we are contributing to sustainable agriculture and preparing for potential large-scale environmental impact.

Location: Assam and Wayanad

KG SPL supports the NGO Goonj in providing disaster relief and rehabilitation provisions across India. This year, we supported their relief and rehabilitation efforts in Assam and other adjoining areas which were severely affected by heavy rains, floods and landslides.

Goonj provided family relief kits to the most affected individuals and families. While the kits were customized per the affected area’s local needs, some more significant components included standard items such as dry rations, blankets, footwear, winter essentials, hygiene essentials, *dari*, towels and tarpaulins. These kits addressed the immediate needs of the affected communities.

Location: Jharkhand

The/Nudge is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to integrated natural resource management and sustainable development in Jharkhand.

(c) Integrated Natural Resource Management

Their mission is to enhance livelihood opportunities for the poorest households by improving land quality and promoting sustainable agricultural practices.

KG SPL supports the initiatives include assisting in soil conservation techniques, land development models and promoting livestock rearing and vegetable cultivation as sustainable livelihood options.

Team Everest



Location: Pan India

Team Everest (TE) is one of the biggest youth-run NGOs in India. They focus on motivating individuals to volunteer and make volunteering a habit, lifestyle among people.

They make a difference by working across SDGs including providing quality education to financially challenged children.

KGSPL has partnered with TE to support the mentorship and skill development program for school and college students. The NGO conducted various initiatives throughout the year for the beneficiaries where KGSPL colleagues volunteered.

Way for Life



Location: Pan India

Way for Life is one of our partner NGOs dedicated to sustained betterment of the planet and people. Their dedication to driving sustainable environmental impact aligns perfectly with our commitment to the planet.

KGSPL supports Way for Life in executing a wide range of volunteering activities where our colleagues play a pivotal role as champions of environmental conservation. The initiatives include making seed balls, assembling school benches with recycled single-use plastic waste and much more. We also support Way for Life in plantation drives within government schools, hospitals and other locations that will help drive a greener, cleaner and healthier community.

Sangath



Location: Pan India

Sangath is one of our partner NGOs committed to improving health across the lifespan by empowering existing community resources to provide appropriate physical, psychological, and social therapies. Its primary focus areas include child development, adolescent and youth health, adult health and chronic disease, public engagement, and work with marginalized populations.

KG SPL has collaborated with Sangath on a project to promote mental health literacy and awareness among school-going students (aged 16 to 22 years) from underserved communities studying in higher secondary grades.

The program will encourage dialogue around mental health and equip students with the skills to understand the phenomenon of basic mental health literacy.

Hands On CSR by Thats Eco Foundation focuses on societal gaps and uplift underdeveloped communities. What began as a grassroots effort grew into a public charitable organization during the pandemic.
