PUBLIC ADVISORY

The Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) has received reports that certain e-Invoicing Service Providers (ESPs), software developers, and other entities are claiming or advertising that they are “BIR-Accredited,” “BIR-Certified,” “BIR-Compliant,” or “BIR-Authorized” providers of electronic invoicing and sales reporting systems.

The BIR clarifies that, as of the date of this Advisory, it has not accredited, authorized, certified, recognized, or endorsed any entity as an official BIR ESP, partner, representative, or solution provider of electronic invoicing and sales reporting systems.

Accordingly, no person or entity may represent, whether verbally, in writing, or through its website, social media account, marketing materials, presentations, proposals, or any other medium, that it is accredited, authorized, recognized, endorsed by, or officially affiliated with the BIR as an ESP. The public is advised to exercise due diligence and verify any such claim exclusively through official BIR issuances and communication channels.

Pending the finalization and issuance of the relevant policies, guidelines, accreditation requirements, and implementation framework for the Electronic Invoicing Program, the Bureau shall temporarily suspend the accommodation of requests from ESps, prospective solution providers, and similar entities for meetings, consultations, courtesy calls, presentations, product demonstrations, technical discussions, business proposals, and other similar engagements concerning accreditation, onboarding, certification, systems integration, product offerings, participation, or other ESP-related matters.

Official announcements, advisories, schedules, requirements, and procedures concerning ESP accreditation, participation, onboarding, technical integration, and engagement shall be issued through the official BIR website and other authorized BIR communication channels once available.

All concerned are advised to await the appropriate BIR policies, guidelines, and official communications.
